



USER GUIDE



1. Insert battery into the AKWatek sensors

- a. Unscrew the sensor (small phillips)
- b. Insert AAA battery as in the picture



2. Programming the sensor with the controller

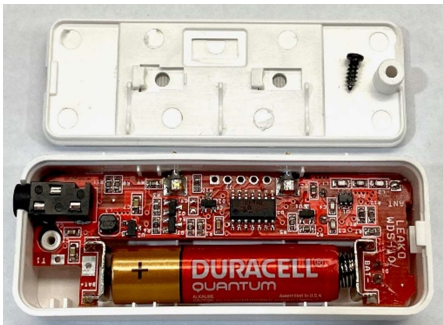
- a. The technician will pair the sensor with the controller
- b. The technician will assign the accurate information about the sensor assignment to the web platform



3. Sensor failure

When a sensor failure occurs, try the following:

- a. Check the location of the sensor
- b. Check if there any physical damage to the sensor
- c. Move the sensor closer to the controller
- d. Replace the battery of the sensor if the controller does not respond when the sensor is activated within short range
