# Simple Troubleshooting

Q1: Not configured A: 1) WiFi name and password should not be in Chinese, not more than 12 digits, but a combination of numbers and letters. 5G WiFi signal is not supported. Please use 2.4G WiFi signal. 2) A software conflict in some part of the mobile phone will also cause network connection failure. Please restart the mobile phone, turn off the non-system software that starts automatically during the starting of the phone, turn on the Bluetooth and positioning of the mobile phone, and then try to reconnect.

### Q2: App cannot connect to the feeder A: Confirm whether the Bluetooth and positioning of the mobile phone are turned on, and reset it before

Q3: The feeder does not feed accurately or does not feed A: Please check whether there is too much food in the food bowl or whether the food channel is blocked. If so, please clean the food channel and the food outlet in time; when using battery power, please check whether the battery is dead or leaking.

### Q4: The feeder shows offline

pairing and connecting.

A: Please check whether the distance between the feeder and the mobile phone at home is more than 10 meters (effective distance 10 meters); try not to have a wall in the middle. According to the characteristics of Bluetooth, the Bluetooth signal will drop sharply when the wall is separated, and the connection will be unstable, which will cause the product to be offline.


