Battery Installation



Looking at the keypad, slide the dark lens cover away from you (STEP 1) and lift the lid from the back (STEP 2).



Install 2 AAA batteries.

Make sure the + and symbols on the metal
hinge of the battery
compartment correspond
with the + and - end of
each battery.



With the keypad facing away from you, close the cover by gently pressing it down (STEP 1) and sliding it until it aligns with the front (keypad) of the device (STEP 2).

Test the remote by pressing the power button. The LED should light up, indicating the batteries are in correctly. If the LED fails to light up, the batteries are either incorrectly inserted or dead.

Reset Instructions (Returns the Remote to Factory Settings)

Press and hold both the POWER and 0 until the LED flashes 3 times. The Remote is now reset and will operate any LG, Samsung, *RCA or *Philips TV (default mode).
