- Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.
- · Risk of burn. Disconnect power and allow fixture to cool before changing bulb or handing fixture.





General Wiring Diagram






Field-Adjustable Wattage & CCT


