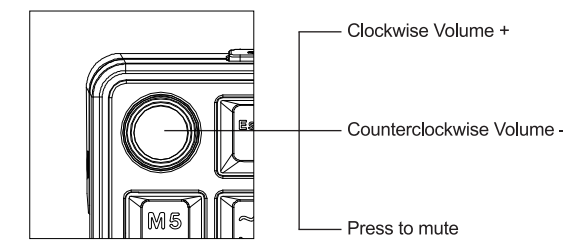

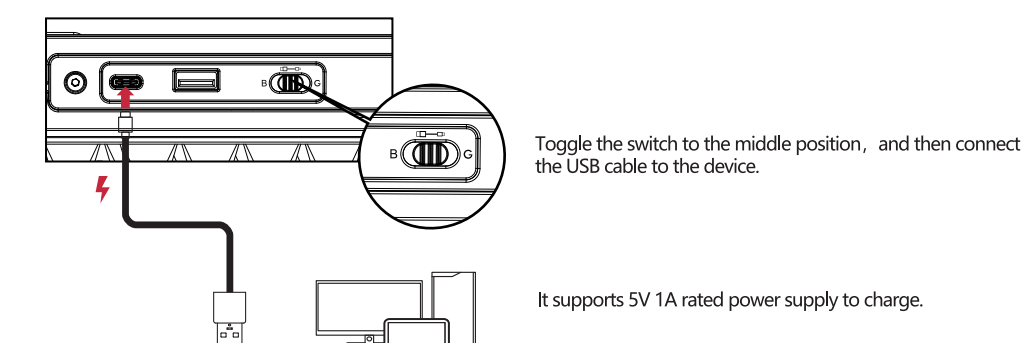

Charging Indication: The red light always lights on when charging, goes off when fully charged, and the red indicator light flashes when the power is low.

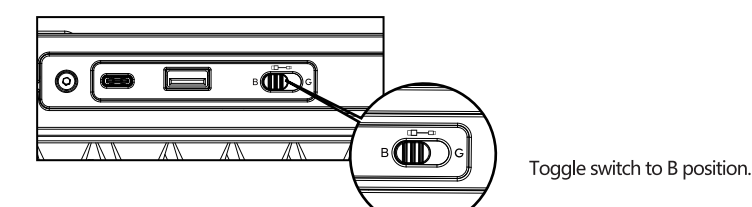

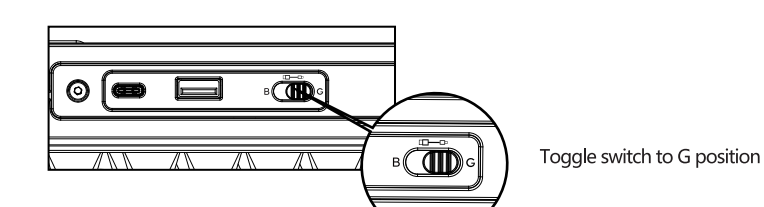

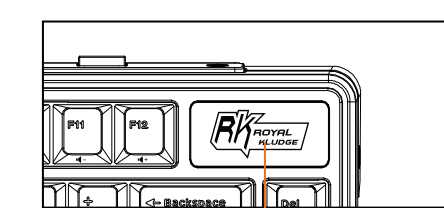

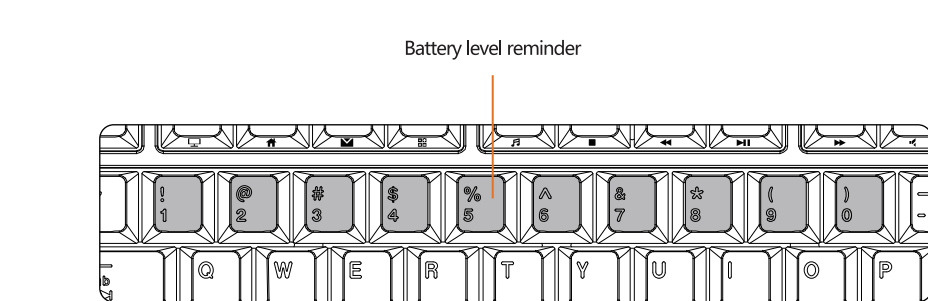

BATTERY LEVEL REMINDER



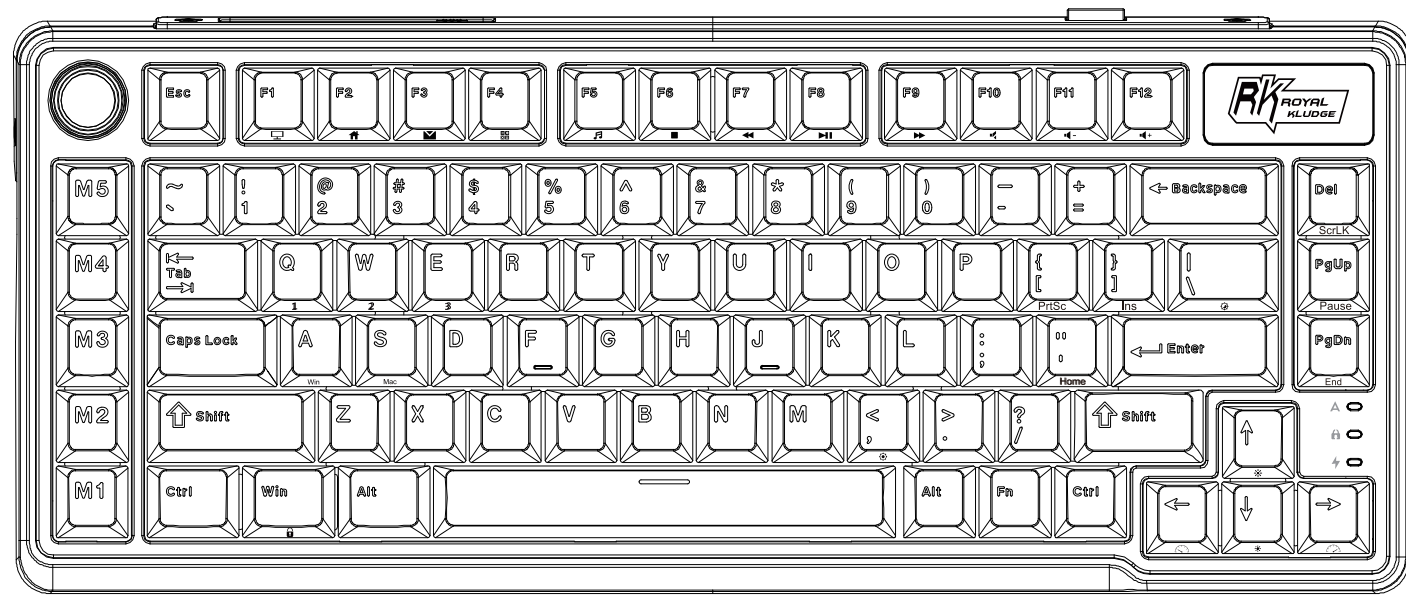
For example
