Please remove the left side when using for the first time. Wear headphones on the right side simultaneously. When the red and blue indicator lights are on the earphones flash alternately, and the earphones will enter Automatic pairing mode.

Long Press

Wake up voice assistant

When using both ears, press and hold the left ear multi-function button for 2 seconds to activate the voice assistant. When using one earphone, press and hold the left (or right) earphone for 2 seconds to activate the voice assistant

Phone mode

Press and hold the left (or right) ear multi-function button for two seconds: call rejection

Triple Press

Music mode

Triple press on the left ear: Previous song

Triple press on the right ear: next song

Clear Bluetooth pairing history

When both ears cannot be paired, you need to clear all connected devices and click the left and right earphones 5 times at the same time.

Wireless pairing mode

1. When there is no pairing record for the left and right earphones, the left and right earphones will automatically pair after they are turned on. After successful pairing, there will be two beeps.

2. When the left and right earphones have pairing records, they will automatically connect back when they are turned on, and the prompt will sound "beep"

Connect with Bluetooth device

Open the Bluetooth settings option of the Bluetooth device to be paired, enter the options and find the Bluetooth pairing name of the headset "MINISO-MS209".Click the pairing name to pair.

Indicator Light Description

When the headset is turned on: Red and blue lights flash alternately
When the headset is turned off: The Red light flashes three times and then goes out.
Successful pairing of left and right ears: The main earphone's Red and blue lights alternate flashing, while the secondary earphone goes out.
Bluetooth device successfully connected: no light

Headphone Charging:The red indicator light on the headphones is still on After being fully charged, the red light turns to blue and stays on for 5-7 seconds. It went out afterwards
Charging of the Charging case: The red indicator light flashes, and after being fully charged, the red light stays on for a long time

Power On

Auto power on: The Earphone are taken out of the charging case, the Earphone will be powered on, with the prompt sound of "Du".
Manual power-on: Long press for 3 seconds, the Earphone will be powered on, with the prompt sound of "Du".

Power Off

Auto power off: Put the Earphone in the charging case, the Earphone will be powered off, with the prompt sound of "Du".
Manual power off: Long press for 5 seconds, the Earphone will be powered off, with the prompt sound of "Du".

Note: After turning on the device, if it is not paired and connected to the Bluetooth device for 3 minutes, it will automatically shut down; Exceeded the effective connection distance and did not connect to the Bluetooth device. After 3 minutes, it will automatically shut down with a beep sound.

Important safety tips
