Overview

The UH3230 4K USB-C Multiport Dock transforms your USB-C or Thunderbolt™ 3 computer into a dual monitor workstation. This all-in-one docking station provides 8 ports that instantly connect and disconnect from your USB-C or Thunderbolt™ 3 computer through a single high speed USB-C cable.

The UH3230 features DisplayPort with Multi-Stream Transport, HDMI, USB 3.1 Gen 1, audio and Gigabit Ethernet ports, allowing your laptop to perform like a desktop. It supports dual view setups and a variety of video converters that can convert HDMI, DVI or VGA outputs for use in dual display modes. The UH3230 can route video from the source device to a DisplayPort and HDMI monitor, splitting the video transmission for a dual view display via a single cable while maintaining a high quality 4K resolution.

The ATEN 4K USB-C docking station provides a front panel USB 3.1 port for high speed data transfers and fast charging of portable devices and will also charge your laptop through the rear panel's USB-C port.

Features

- ◆ Connect up to 8 devices to a laptop through a single USB-C cable
- ◆ Supports 4K video resolutions via a DisplayPort or HDMI display
- ◆ Supports dual monitors in mirror and extended mode up to 1080p*
- ◆ Supports USB Power Delivery 2.0 for charging a laptop via USB-C ports**
- ◆ USB 3.1 Gen 1 front panel port supports Fast-Charging***

Note:

1. Mac computers only support a single-view output.
2. The UH3230 will not charge a device that uses a proprietary USB-C charging interface. Supported power profiles include 20V/3A, 20V/1.8A, 12V/3A, and 5V/3A.
3. Supports Apple Charging (5V/2.1A) when the host is disconnected.

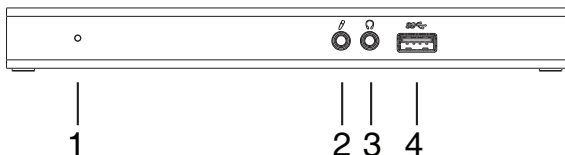

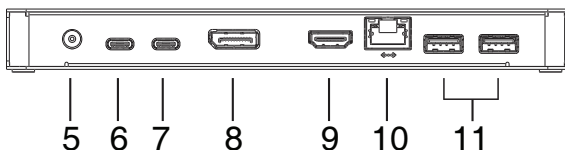

| No. | Component | Description |
|-----|------------------------------------|---|
| 1 | Power LED | This LED lights green to indicate the UH3230 is powered on. |
| 2 | Audio In Port | The cable from your microphone plugs in here. |
| 3 | Audio Out Port | The cable from your speakers plug in here. |
| 4 | USB 3.1 Gen 1 Port (Fast Charging) | This port is used to connect a USB-C enabled computer or device and can be used for charging. |
| 5 | DC Power Jack | The power adapter cable plugs into this jack. |
| 6 | USB-C Host Port | The cable from your USB-C enabled computer plugs into this port. |
| 7 | USB-C Data Port | The cable from your USB-C peripheral device plugs into this port. |
| 8 | DisplayPort Port | The cable from a DisplayPort monitor plugs into this port. |
| 9 | HDMI Port | The cable from an HDMI monitor plugs into this port. |
| 10 | Gigabit LAN Port | The Ethernet cable that connects to the network plugs in here. |
| 11 | USB 3.1 Gen 1 Ports | The cables from two USB 3.0/2.0/1.1 peripheral devices plug into these ports. |

Installation



1. Make sure that the power to any device that you connect to the installation has been turned off.
2. Make sure that all devices you will be installing are properly grounded.

Drivers

Windows

1. Download the Windows driver from www.aten.com
2. Save the **zip** file where you can easily locate it.
3. Unzip the driver and run Setup.exe. The driver will install and a reboot might be necessary.

Mac

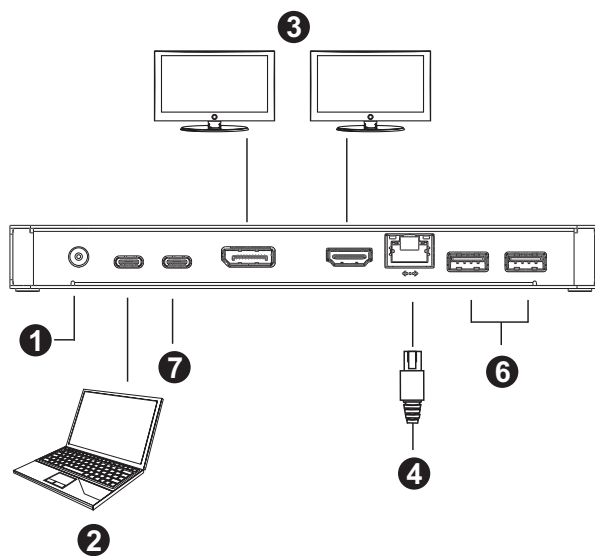
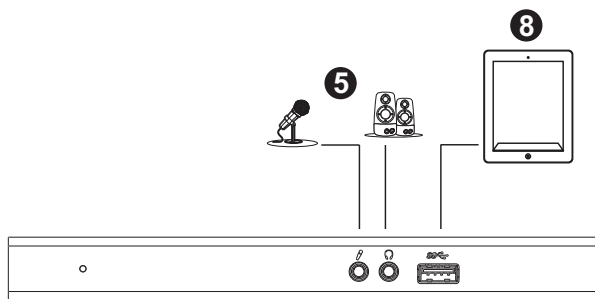
1. Download the Mac OS X driver from www.aten.com
2. Save the **dmg** file where you can easily locate it.
3. Run the **dmg** file. The driver will install and a reboot might be necessary.

Hardware

To setup the UH3230, use the diagram on the next page (the numbers in the diagram correspond with the numbered instructions below), and do the following:

1. Plug the included AC power adapter to the DC power port on the UH3230. The green power LED should light on the front panel.
2. Use the included USB-C cable to connect the USB-C enabled computer to the Host port (provides USB Power Delivery capability*).
3. Connect an HDMI and/or DisplayPort monitor to their respective port on the UH3230. The computer will automatically detect the additional display.
4. Use an Ethernet cable to connect the Gigabit LAN port to an Internet connection.
5. Use audio cables to connect the Audio In and Audio Out ports to a microphone and speakers.
6. Use USB cables to connect USB 3.0/2.0/1.1 peripheral devices to the USB 3.1 Gen 1 ports.
7. Use a USB-C cable to connect a compatible peripheral device to the USB-C Data port.
8. Use a USB cable to connect the front panel USB 3.1 Gen1 port to a peripheral device (provides fast charging).

*The UH3230 can charge a USB-C powered laptop if the power adapter shows a specification of 20V/3A, 20V/1.8A, 12V/3A, or 5V/3A for the output power.

External Monitor Settings: Mac OS X

Option 1: Extend Mode

1. Open *System Preferences* and click **Displays**.
2. Click on **Arrangement** to change the position of the displays currently connected.

Option 2: Mirror Mode

1. Open *System Preferences* and click **Displays**.
2. Click on **Arrangement**.
3. Click the box marked *Mirror Displays*.

External Sound Settings: Mac OS X

1. Open *System Preferences* and click **Sound**.
2. Click on **Arrangement** to change the sound-output device to the currently connected USB DAC.
