

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY

### ⚠️ WARNING

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury, or property damage, when using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

#### READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS VACUUM

1. Replace power cord only with a plug of the same rating. If it is damaged, DO NOT use vacuum cleaner. If it is not safe, have it repaired or replaced by a qualified service technician before using it again.
2. Use only a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). Reverse the plug if it does not fit. DO NOT use if the cord is frayed, damaged, or has been cut, broken, or if power is interrupted.
3. Your vacuum cleaner may consist of a motorized nozzle, wand, hose, and vacuum pod. These components require connections between various parts and may be present due to the use.
4. Use only identical replacement parts.
5. Carefully observe the following instructions provided below to avoid improper use of the appliance.
6. DO NOT use the vacuum for any purpose other than those described in this manual.
7. Before use, carefully inspect all parts for any damage. DO NOT use if any parts are damaged.
8. This is not an aspirator vacuum. DO NOT aspirate liquids.
9. This vacuum cleaner is not to be used by persons such as infants, children, or disabled individuals or lack of experience and knowledge if they have their own personal or medical conditions concerning use of the appliance. If you are uncertain about the safety of your child cleaning and/or maintenance, and/or the use of this vacuum, consult a physician.
10. Always turn off the vacuum cleaner before connecting or disconnecting any motorized nozzle or other accessories.
11. DO NOT handle plug or power cord cleaner with wet hands.
12. DO NOT clean without the canister.
13. Only use shark recommended filters and accessories.
14. DO NOT damage the power cord.
15. DO NOT pull or carry vacuum cleaner by the cord or use the cord as a handle.
16. DO NOT stand by pulling on cord. Grasp the plug, not the cord.
17. DO NOT run the vacuum cleaner over the power cord, close a door on the cord, pull the cord around sharp corners, or kink the cord under heavy objects.
18. DO NOT use a vacuum cleaner on extremely cold temperatures. DO NOT leave vacuum operating unattended, even for short periods of time.


## OWNER'S GUIDE

### CLEANING MODES



UPRIGHT MODE

To engage Brushroll indicator light mode and alternate surface my. Press the Power/Release switch to the upright floor setting.



ABOVE FLOOR MODE


Press the Handle Release button and lift up on the handle to detach it from the wand.



ABOVE FLOOR + WAND MODE


Press the Wand Release button and pull up on the wand to connect it to the handle.

In Lift-Away mode, you can clean with the handle or with the handle and the wand.



LIFT AWAY

Press the Lift-Away switch to dock the wand on the handle.



LIFT AWAY

With the handle, press the Wand Release button and dock the wand from the pod.




LIFT AWAY

Press the Handle Release button and pull up on the handle to dock it onto the wand.

### WHOLE-HOME CLEANING


#### SETTINGS



Switch Surface Setting:

- 0 OFF
- I Bare Floor  
For bare floors and area rugs
- II Brushroll On  
For carpet cleaning

**NOTE:** The brushroll switch cannot be used at the same time.



The Button Control Slider located on the handle allows you to adjust the suction depending on the condition.

- Off to reduce suction and increase maneuverability on carpets.
- Max to increase suction on bare floors.

**NOTE:** The brushroll switch cannot be used at the same time.

#### BRUSHROLL INDICATOR LIGHT

**WHAT DOES THE BRUSHROLL INDICATOR LIGHT MEAN?**


**Solid Green:** The brushroll is rotating and working as intended.

**Solid Red:** There is a jam in the brushroll area. Turn off the vacuum and unjam it, then remove any obstructions in the nozzle.


**Flashing Red:** The motorized floor nozzle is overloading. Turn off the vacuum, unplug it and remove any obstructions. Let the vacuum cool down for 10-15 minutes before restarting.

**No Light:** The brushroll is still.


**NOTE:** For deep carpet cleaning, see AGTH1000 (removable dirt bin carpet), see MAX dust bin and use setting II Brushroll On.




To remove dust cup, lift the suction arm above then flip off the CUP CUP.



And the dust cup over a trash receptacle and press the cap release button. Tap gently to make sure it's locking and it will be placed.



To remove debris from the Link Block, lift up on the top release button and lift the handle to open. Turn the brush roller off the base.




Then slide the Link Block into the Link Block slot. Press the top release button and lift the handle to open. Turn the brush roller off the base.

## CLEANING AND REPLACING THE FILTERS

### CLEANING FILTERS


Regularly clean and replace the filters to maintain your vacuum's suction power.  
To prevent damage from cleaning chemicals, never clean with cold water or ice. Allow filters to dry for at least 24 hours before re-installing them to prevent liquid from seeping down into electric parts.

**IMPORTANT! DO NOT use water when cleaning the filters.**



#### CLEAN PRE-MOTOR FILTERS EVERY 3 MONTHS

Remove the dust cup, then lift out the Pre-Motor Filter.



#### RINSE HEPA FILTER EVERY YEAR

To access the HEPA filter, press the button on the bottom of the Filter Door and lift up. Pull the HEPA filter to remove. Insert the HEPA filter into the slot and replace the Filter door.

### REPLACING FILTERS

Follow the new box instructions for removing filters. The Pre-Motor Filter should be replaced every 2.5 years. The HEPA Filter should be replaced every 5 years.





## CLEANING THE BRUSHROLL

When your brushroll needs to be cleaned your vacuum will automatically shut down. The indicator light will turn red, warning you to turn off the vacuum and clear the blockage immediately. The type of debris on the floor can determine if the power has been turned off or if the vacuum has reached its maximum suction.




Unplug the cord and allow the motor to cool down.



Locate the brushroll. Unplug the cord and the Brushroll. Remove any debris buildup. With tweezers, carefully remove any fibers or other wrapped debris from the brushroll. Avoid damaging or cutting the wires.


## CORD MAINTENANCE



- DO NOT pull or carry vacuum cleaner by the cord or use cord as a handle.
- DO NOT step on or roll over the cord. Drag the plug, not the cord.
- DO NOT drag the debris on the cord.
- DO NOT pull the cord around sharp corners.
- DO NOT leave the cord near heated surfaces.

To minimize the risk of power cord damage, DO NOT unplug the vacuum over the power cord. If the power cord is damaged, shut off power to the vacuum and remove the cord from the electrical outlet.

## CHECKING FOR BLOCKAGES




### WAND BLOCKAGES

Detach hose from floor nozzle and handle, and check wand for blockages.



### NOZZLE BLOCKAGES

Detach hose, pull the bottom of the nozzle out of the connector, and release the top of the hose by squeezing the tabs together. Check the hose and the openings for blockages.




### HANDLE/HOSE BLOCKAGES

Detach nozzle from wand and hose from the vacuum pod, and check openings for blockages.



### DUST CUP BLOCKAGES

Detach dust cup from vacuum pod. Empty just the remove debris from it. Check the filter for blockages in their slots.



### POD BLOCKAGES

Detach hose from the vacuum pod, and check openings for blockages.



### POD BLOCKAGES

Detach dust cup from the vacuum pod, and check openings for blockages.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### Power cord caught in brushroll or floor nozzle.

- To minimize the risk of power cord damage, DO NOT unplug the vacuum over the power cord. If the power cord is damaged, shut off power to the vacuum and remove the cord from the handle or nozzle.
- Inspect power cord and plug for damage, and before use, DO NOT use vacuum cleaner with a damaged cord or plug. Turn off the switch before unplugging it or unplugging the vacuum cleaner. See "How to Turn On/Off" in the "How to Use" section for more information about the two cord hooks.

### Vacuum is not picking up debris. No suction or light suction.

- Check filter bags. They need cleaning. Follow instructions for cleaning and re-attach the filter before re-starting.
- Dust cup may be full, empty and re-plug.
- Check any blockages in the hose, hose connector, nozzle, wand, pod, or accessories for debris or obstructions. Refer to "Cleaning or Blockages section" for more information.

### Vacuum fills areas rug.

- Make sure "Allow Dual Floor Surface Selection" is set to "Dual Floor Cleaning".
- Run on carpet. Take care when vacuuming areas with rug with relatively worn edges.
- To minimize suction, set the suction control slide X-HV. See the Section Controls section for more information.

### Brushroll does not spin.

- If the Brushroll indicator light turns red, immediately turn off and unplug the vacuum. Remove plug from floor nozzle and clear any blockages. Reconnect power, turn on vacuum, and turn on power.
- With the power on, unplug the cord and rotate the handle, which will automatically turn on the brushroll.

### Vacuum turns off on its own or indicator light flashes red.

If your vacuum continues, the thermostat will automatically turn off the motor. Follow these steps to restart:

- Turn vacuum off and unplug it.
- Empty and clean dust bin (see "Emptying the Dust Cup and Cleaning the Filters").
- Check for blockages in hose, wand, nozzle, accessories, and intake openings.
- Allow unit to cool for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- Plug in vacuum and turn it on.

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

- ⑥ Dusting Brush




### ASSEMBLY

1. Push the Vacuum Pod onto the Floor Nozzle Post.
2. Insert the Wand into the post.
3. Turn about the Handle to the top of the wand.
4. Connect the Hose to the back of the pod.
