



HOW TABLO WORKS



Free network TV channels are broadcast from local towers to your TV antenna.

The Tablo device connects to your TV antenna and to your home's Wi-Fi.

Tablo sends live and recorded TV wirelessly to every room in your home.

Tablo doesn't come with a remote control because it doesn't connect directly to your television. Once your Tablo device and antenna are set up, you'll use the remote that came with your smart TV or streaming device to control your Tablo through the Tablo app installed on the smart TV or streaming device.

Library


See and manage your DVR schedules and recordings.

Settings

Select the gear icon in the top right to run a new channel scan, edit your channel lineup, format external recording storage (optional) and manage other Tablo device settings.





WHERE TO PLACE YOUR TABLO

Before starting, select a location in your home for your Tablo.



Choose a place located:


- Near your TV antenna (if you have one installed already).
- Near a power outlet (your Tablo device must remain powered on at all times).
- Near your Wi-Fi router if possible (if not, you can connect your Tablo to your network wirelessly).

*Position your TV antenna near a window on the top floor of your home, facing the direction of your local broadcast towers, and away from obstructions like trees

Because Tablo delivers live and recorded TV to your screens wirelessly via your home internet network, your TV antenna and your Tablo device do not need to be near your television.

HOW TO MOUNT THE TV ANTENNA



Once you've identified a good location for your TV antenna:

- 1. Remove the protective seal on both sides of the antenna.
- Attach the antenna directly onto any non-metallic surface with the provided double sided stickers. The height of the antenna should be less than 6.5ft.
- Once you have completed setup and confirmed the optimal location, use the adhesive stickers provided to securely mount the antenna and the optional cable clips to tidy the coaxial cable.

The included TV antenna is reversible, so you can choose to have the white or black side facing out to match your decor.

ACCESSING TABLO ON YOUR TV

Once you've completed the previous steps of setting up your Tablo with your smartphone or tablet, it's easy to connect your Tablo to other compatible devices in your home.



From your smart TV or streaming device's home screen, navigate to the app store and search for Tablo. Once you download and open the Tablo app, it will automatically find and connect to your Tablo over your home network.

Can't locate the Tablo app when searching the app store? You may need to upgrade to a newer model of compatible streaming device or connect a compatible streaming device to your television.

FINAL STEPS

Now that your Tablo device is connected to your home's internet network, you can complete the final setup steps.

Update Firmware

You may be prompted to download and install new firmware on your Tablo. This should only take a few minutes and ensure you have the best possible experience.

Set Your Location

To provide you with accurate TV listings, you must allow the Tablo app to discover your location and confirm your zip code.

Scan for Channels

Your Tablo will then use your TV antenna to scan for available local channels and use the internet to detect the included free streaming channels. If an antenna TV channel you expected to receive is not found or is not coming in with adequate signal strength, reposition your TV antenna and rescan.



Edit Your Lineup

Select the channels you would like to add or remove from your live TV guide.

Download Schedule

Once you've saved your channel lineup, your Tablo will automatically download TV guide listings for the next 24 hours. Additional data for the coming weeks will be downloaded in the background.



Wait approximately 30 minutes to allow all TV guide data listings to download before creating series recording schedules.

TABLO DEVICE CONNECTIONS

Now that you've selected the ideal location for your Tablo device, it's time to connect it.

Connect TV Antenna

Connect the end of your TV antenna's coaxial cable to the antenna port on the far right of the back of the Tablo. Finger tighten only.




Connect Power Adapter

Plug the large end of the included power adapter into the nearest wall outlet and the small end into the power port on the far left of the back of your Tablo.



Connect Ethernet Cable (Optional)

Connect one end to your home's Wi-Fi router and the other to the Ethernet port on the left side of the back of your Tablo. (Skip this step if your Wi-Fi router is not nearby.)



When connected, follow the prompts on the Tablo app installed on your smartphone or tablet to set up your account and finish setting up your Tablo device.



Do not connect the Ethernet cable if you are planning to connect your Tablo to the internet via Wi-Fi.

CONNECTING YOUR TABLO VIA WI-FI (Optional)

1. Check LED and Network

Ensure your Tablo's blue LED is pulsing slowly and that your smartphone or tablet is connected to the same home Wi-Fi network you'd like to use for your Tablo.

2. Connect to Your Tablo's Network

The app will prompt you to join Tablo's unique network (e.g., Tablo_XXXX). This will only appear during setup.

3. Join Your Home Wi-Fi Network

Select your home network so your Tablo can connect to it.

4. Enter Your Wi-Fi Network Password

Home network passwords are case-sensitive. Take care to enter your password correctly.

Once your Tablo device has successfully connected, its blue LED will stop flashing and turn solid blue. If your Tablo device does not connect successfully, or you encounter issues during Wi-Fi setup, visit tablotv.com/start for resources and troubleshooting tips.









To proceed with Wi-Fi setup, ensure your Tablo device is NOT connected via Ethernet and that all Virtual Private Networks (VPNs) are disabled as this will prevent device-to-device communications.
