What has launched?

We have launched our new **Customs Clearance and Shipping Services (C2S2)** Premium Full Truck Load (FTL) Shipping Solution, in collaboration with RXO (formerly known as UPS SCS) and AVASK. This service is designed to streamline and enhance your cross-border operations between the United Kingdom and Europe.

Here is how you can get started:

- ✓ Get onboarded with C2S2 by completing this **form.**
- ✓ Get onboarded with RXO filling this **form** if you never shipped with them.
- ✓ If you have previously shipped with RXO, reach out to **upsamazon@ups.com** and request contract rate agreement (CRA) change before shipping.
- ✓ Please await confirmation from AVASK and RXO on your successful onboarding.
- Create a shipment in Send to Amazon.
- ✓ Get Commercial Invoice approval via **AVASK portal** or contact AVASK for support through your dedicated Account Manager.
- ✓ Book your RXO shipment and provide manifest to upsamazon@ups.com (Ensure you have approval from AVASK to ship before booking your collection with RXO).
- ✓ Send your Full Truck Load and receive inbound confirmation within 3-4 days*.
