A WARNING: To reduce the risk of electric shock, this appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). This plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. DO NOT modify the plug in any way.

A WARNING: Extension cords are not recommended for use with this product.

A WARNING: Remove utensils prior to processing. Failure to remove may cause the jar to be damaged or to shatter which may cause personal injury.

A WARNING: Stacked Blade Assembly is sharp, not locked in place and removable, handle with care. When handling the Stacked Blade Assembly always hold it by the shaft. Failure to so will result in risk of laceration.

**WARNING:** Do not immerse the motor base into water or any other liquid.

A WARNING: Handle the Stacked Blade Assembly with care when washing, as the blades are very sharp.



The Ninja' Professional Blender 1000 is a high powered kitchen tool that is perfect for ice crushing, blending, pureeing and controlled processing. Create all of your favorite recipes quickly and easily with just one touch of a button. For best results, be sure to carefully read all the instructions contained in the manual before using this appliance.

### BEFORE FIRST USE



# ASSEMBLY & USE OF THE PITCHER

- Review the Important Sarety Instructions on pages 1-2 before proceeding to stop 2.
- Pitce the motor base or a clear, ory. level surface such as a counter or telo etop.




3 Align and lower the pitcher anto the motor base.



Rotate the pitcher clockwise until it ocks in place. You will hear a click. when the lock is engaged.



5. The pitcher can be placed on the motor. base love ways; the handle can be on the front right cornandrate front left corner. 6 Holding the Stacked Blade Assembly by the top of the shaft, place it anto the drive gear inside the pitcher. Ensure the Stacked Blade Assembly is scated properly and is standing upright.



NOTE: The Stacked Blode Assembly will fit, possily on the drive gear

Add the ingredients to the pitchet, making sure they do not exceed the highest measured marking line on the side of the pitches

NOTE: I you need to add additional ingred onts while the applicace is processing, open the pour soout capand pour the ingredients in through the opening.

NOTE: When blending any kind of liquids, such as mixtures of any chinks or smoothies, do not exceed the "Max Liquid" mark (64 ounces) on the pitcher.

. Plug the power corn into the a actrical outlet and press the power button (Φ).

IMPORTANT: As a safety feature, the power button (C) will flash and the motor will not work if the pitcher and lid are not installed correctly. When the pitcher and lid are installed properly, the power button (c) will be solid, indicating the blender is ready for use.

Accessory type and quantity may vary depending on the model.



### ASSEMBLY & USE OF THE PITCHER - CONT.



- 9 Holding the lid by the handle in the upright position, place it on top of the oitcher, aligning the arrow (♥) located on the lid with the arrow (▲) located on the bitcher's handle. Press the handle down until you near a click
- 10 Select the speed according to your blanding requirements\*
  - Use the LOW setting for processing and mixing
  - use the MEDIUM setting for blending. and de crushing
  - Use the HIGH setting for pureeing. and liquefying.
  - Use the PULSE button for controlled. chapping and processing
  - 'See Dignoing Chart.

NOTE: Pulse ingredients for even. chapping by pressing down in short intervals.



11 When ingredients have reached your. desired consistency, stop the appliance by pressing the power button (b) and weit for the Stacked Blade Assambly to soop turning.



- 12 To remove the lid, press the release button on the fid, pull the fig hande up to a 90° engle, and lift the lid off. Jurn the pitcher counterclockwise and then lift off the base.
- 13 Open the pour spout cap and use the spout to empty liquid contents.

For thicker consistencies, first removethe lid by pressing the release butter and builing the lid handle up to a 90. degree angic to lift iid off the pitcher. Then, carefully remove the Stacket Blade Assembly by the top of the shaft. Place Stacked Blade Assembly away from the work area to avoid accidental. contact. Finally empty contents from the pitcher,

#### TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Motor doesn't start or Stocked Blade Assembly doesn't rotate.

Make sure the pitcher is securely blaced on motor base. Make sure the ligits securely on pitcher in the correct position (align arrows) The blander is turned off. Press the power button (4) to our or

Check that the plug is securely inserted into the electrical outlet. Check the fuse or circuit breazer.

The unit has everheated. Unplug and wait approximately iS minutes before using again.

Ingredients are unevenly chopped.

Fither you are shapping too many ingredients at one time, or the pieces are not of eyon. size. Processisma ler amounts per betch.

- ingredients are chopped too fine or is too watery.
- The ingredients have been over-processed. Use FULSE button for controlled processing,
- ingredients collects on lid or on the sides of the pitcher.

The mixture is too thick. Add more liquid.

You cannot achieve snow from solid ice.

Do not use ice that has been sitting out or has started to more. Use ice straight from the freezer and make sure the pitcher is completely dry before adding ice.

# CLEANING

- Séparate all parts from each other.
- Hand-Washing: Wash the picher. lict, and Stanked Islade Assembly in: warm soapy water When washing ne Stacked Diade Assembly luse a dishwashing utensif with a handle to avoid direct hand contact with blades. Handle blace assembly with care to avoid contact with sharp edges. Rinse and air-dry thoroughly
  - Dishwasher: The pitcher, id. and Stacked Blade Assembly are all dishwasher safe. The lid and Stacked Blade Assembly are top, rock dishwasher safe, Ensure the Stacked Blade Assembly is removed from the pitcher before bisking in the dishwasher.
- Wipe the motor base clean with a camp cloth.

#### RESETTING THE MOTOR THERMOSTAT

- Unplugithe uninfrom the electrical.
- 2 Remove and empty the pitcher and ensure no ingredients are jamming the Stacked Blade Assembly.
- 3 Allow the unit to sool for approximately 45 remetes:
- 4. Place the pitcher onto the base and olugithe unit into the electrical outlet.
- Proceed to use the unit as before, naking sure to not exceed the recommended maximum capacities.

NOTE:

In order to ensure the highest possible standard for refurbished items, all units are thoroughly inspected as part of the process. For this item, water may be used during the refurbishing process and so; you may notice some condensation in the water reservoir. It is recommended to rinse the water reservoir with fresh water prior to its first use.

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
