IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

▲ WARNING

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury, or property damage, when using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS VACUUM

- Inspect power cord and plug for any damage before use, **DO NOT** use vacuum cleaner with a damaged cord or clug. Turn off all controls before plugging in or unplugging the vacuum cleaner. Store your vacuum cleaner with the power cord secured around the two cord hooks. To min mize the risk of power cord damage, do not allow the motorized brush roll to ingest the coro. If this occurs, immediately shut off power to the vacuum and remove the cord.
- This appliance has a colarized plug, if the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug (one blade is wider than the other). If it still does not fit, contact a qualif eó e estrician. **DO NOT** force into outlet or try to: modify to fit.
- Your vacuum cleaner may consist of a motorized nozzle, wand, nose, and/ or vacuum poe. His device contains electrical connections, electrical value poets that wiring, and moving parts that potentially present risk to the user.
- Use only identical replacement parts.
- Carefully observe and follow the Instructions provided below to avoid Improper use of the appliance. DO NOT use the vacuum for any purpose other than those described in this manual
- Defore use, carefully inspect all parts for any damage, **DO NOT** use if any parts are camaged.
- The use of an extension cord is NOT recommended.
- This vacuum disaper contains no serviceable carts.
- This appliance can be used by persons with reduced physical sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the nazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children. **DO NOT** allow the appliance to be used by children, D-D NOT allow to be used as a toy. Close supervision is necessary when used. near children.
- 10. Always turn off the vacuum cleaner before connecting or disconnecting. any motorized negales or other. accessories.
- 11. DO NOT handle plug or vaccum cleaner with wet hands.
- 12. DO NOT use without filters in place.
- Only use Shark* pranded filters. and accessories
- 14. DO NOT carrage the power coro: a) DO NOT pull or carry vacuum cleaner by the cord or use the cord as a handle.
 - b) DO NOT unplug by pulling on cord. Gresp the clug, not the cord.
 - c) DO NOT run the vacuum cleaner over the power corol close a door on the cord, pull the cord around sharp comers, or eave the core near neated surfaces.
- 15. DO NOT put any objects into nozzle or accessory openings, DO NOT use with any opening blocked; keep free of built, Irc, bair, and anything that may reduce aidiow.

- 16. DO NOT use if nozzle or accessory air flow is restricted. If the air paths or the motorized floor nozzle become. blocked, turn the vectors clearer off and unplug from electrical outlet Remove all obstructions before you plug in end turn on the unit agein
- Keep nozzie and all vacuum openings. away from hair, face, fingers. uncovered feet, or loose diothing
- 18. DO NOT use if vacuum cleaner is not working as it should, or has been propped damaged, left putdoors, or propped into water
- Use extra care when cleaning.
- 20. DO NOT leave the vacuum cleaner anettended while plugged in
- 21. When powered on, keep the vacuum dieaner moving over the caract surface at all times to avoid damaging the carpat fibers.
- 22. DO NOT place vacuum cleaner or costable surfaces such as chairs. or tables.
- 23. Your Shark? vacuum may not be designed to stand up on its own. When taking a break from cleaning. you may need to lear it against furniture or a wall, or lay it flat on the floor, Using the vaccom for an application where the unit lacks stability may result in personal injury.
- 24. DO NOT use to pick up:
 - a) iouida
 - b) Large objects
 - d) Hard or sharp objects (glass, nails, screws, or coins).
 - d) Large quantities of oust (crywall bust, freplace ash, or embers). DO NOT use as an attachment to power tools for dust pollection.

 - f) Flammable or computable materials (lighter fluid, gasoline, or karosena)

- 27. Unplug from electrical outlet when not in use and before any maintenance or cleaning.
- 28. Hand wath with water only Washing with cleaning chemicals could carrage the unit
- 29. During cleaning or routine maintenance, DO NOT out enything other than heir, ficers, or string wrapped around the brushroll.
- 30. A low all filters to air-dry completely before replacing in the vacuum to prevent liquid from being drawn
- 31. Make sure the dust dup and at ficers are in place after routine maintenance.
- \$2. If provided, secure the power cord around the two cord hooks during storage

ASSEMBLY The image shown here is for illustrative purposes only and may be subject to change. 3 Tools not included

- 1. Place Vacuum Pod onto Floor Nozzle Post until it clicks into place. With vacuum in the upright position, connect the **Neazle Hose** from the public the **Floor Neazle**. Push with a slight turning motion to create a snug fit.
- 2. Side Handle into the top of the pod. Align the hose holder on the handle with the cord hooks on the back of the god. Secure handle assembly in place with included boit.
- Insert the Extension Wand through the ring and into the top of the nozzle hose.
- 4. Attach Flexible Hose:

For proper operation, ensure all parts are firmly clicked into place.

a. Insert hose into Swivel Connector until it clicks into place.
b. Route hose through anti-tip hook to prevent vecuum from tipping. c. Run hose over upper holder.

 d. Insert hose securely into top of extension wand. 5. You can store cleaning tools on the Accessory Post on the back of the pod.



WHAT DOES THE BRUSHROLL INDICATOR LIGHT MEAN?

BRUSHROLL INDICATOR LIGHT

Solid Greens The brushroll is spirning and working as it should.

Solid Red: There is a jam in the brushfoll. area. Turn off the vacuum and unplug it, then remové any blockages in the nozzle


No Light: The vacuum is off.


Flashing Red: The motorized floor nazzle is: overheating. Turn off the vacuum, unplug it, and remove any binckages. Lef the vacuum cool down for at least 60 minutes before restarting. See Troubleshooting section for more nicrmation.


- To engage Brushroll, turn power on then place foot on noor nozzle and tilt handle back.


EMPTYING THE DUST CUP



IMPORTANT: Unplug the power cord before performing any maintenance.




To remove Dust Cup, press the Dust Cup Release button next to the handle. If it dust cup, then lift to remove.



To empty debris into trash, press Lawer Release button and bottom of cust cup will drap open.



To remove collected debris from Lint Screen. press Top Release outton and lift handle to open. Gently brush int screen to clean.



To reinstall, place bottom of oust our into ped and then tilt until it clicks into clace.


CLEANING AND REPLACING THE FILTERS

CLEANING FILTERS

Regularly rinse and replace the filters to maintain your vacuum's suction power.

To provent damage from cleaning chemicals, tinse filters with cold water only. Allow all filters to air-dry for at least 24 hours before reinstailing them to prevent liquid from being drawn into electric parts.

IMPORTANTS DO NOT use soap when cleaning the filters.



Pre-Motor (foam and felt): With the dust cup removed take out the Foom and Felt Filters.

CLEAN PRE-MOTOR FILTERS EVERY 3 MONTHS.


Post-Motor Filter:

To access the Post-Motor Filter, press the tab tilt the **Filter Cover** and lift it away from the vacuum. Remove the **Post-Motor Filter**.

CLEAN POST-MOTOR FILTER EVERY YEAR.

REPLACING FILTERS

Fallow the arexigus instructions for removing filters. The Pre-Motor form and felt filters should be replaced every 2.5 years. The Post Motor Filter should be replaced every 8 years.




Replacement Pre-Motor Foam & Felt Filter Kit XFF80




Replacement Post-Motor Fliter

CLEANING THE BRUSHROLL



- 1. Detach the vectors pad from floor nazzle
- 2. Remove any blockages or buildup from the airways in the nozzle. With soi-sors, carefully out away any fibers, hair, or string tyrapped around the preshrall. Avaid damaging or outting the bristles.


CHECKING FOR BLOCKAGES




Remove dust cup. Disconnect hose. Check air occupation dust cup for dogs.



Remove nazzle hase and aneck for dags:



Check opening behind the brushvoll for clogand clear away any obstructions.



Remove hase from both the vacuum podand the extension wans, inspect the length of the hase for diags.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Vacuum is not picking up dirt. No suction or light suction.

- Check filters to see if they need cleaning. Follow instructions for nineing and drying the filters before. roinstailing. See Cleaning the Filters for more information.
- Bust cup may be full, empty dust cup.
- Check hoses, hose connections, nozzle, and accessores for blockages; clear blockages.
- Slide back the systion control buston on the flexible hase to increase suction power.
- If third cup is empty, and education in this are clear ideals for other blockages.
 See Electing for Blockages for more information.

Vecuum lifts eres rugs.

Suction is powerful. Take care when vacuuming preprings or rugs with delitately sewn edges. Silve the suction control button on the hose forward to decrease suction bower.

Brushroff is jammed or has shut off.

Immediately turn off and unplug vacuum, disconnect the nozels, and remove blockage before reconnecting
and turning vacuum back on. See Checking for Blockages for more information.

Version forms off on its own or indicator light fleshes red. flyour vacuum pyerheats, the thormostat will submetically burn off the motor. Follow these steps to research

- I. Tuni vaccom off and criping it.
- 2. Smpty dust cup and clean filters.
- 3. Check for blockages in hoses, wand, nozzle, accessories, and inlet openings.
- 4. Allow unit to cool for a minimum of 60 minutes.
- 5. Plug in vacuum and turn it on.





ASSEMBLY

- Place Vacuum Pod onto Floor Nozzle Post, and slide it down until it clicks into place. With the vacuum in the upright position. connect the Nozzle Hose from the pod to the Floor Nozzle. Push with a slight turning motion to create a snug fit.
- Slide Handle into the top of the pod. Use a Phillips-head screwdriver and the included bolt to secure handle in place.
- Insert the Extension Wand through the ring and into the top of the nozzle hose.
- 4. Attach Flexible Hose:
- a. Insert hose Into Swivel Connector until it clicks into place.
- b. Route hose through anti-tip hook to prevent vacuum from tipping.
- c. Run hose over upper holder.
- d. Insert hose securely Into top of extension wand.
