Important Safety Instructions & Warnings

BEFORE USING THIS MACHINE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND CAUTIONARY MARKINGS IN THIS MANUAL AND ON THE MACHINE

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:



Do not use near open flames



Do not store near heat sources



Do not pick up water or liquids



Do not pick up burning objects



Do not put hands near the brush bar when the machine is in use



Do not place on or near the cooker

- **Do not** use to pick up water or any other liquid, as this may cause electric shock.
- Do not use to pick up sharp objects such as glass or screws, etc.
- Do not use the appliance to pick up flammable liquid, matches, cigarette ends, hot ashes or any hot, burning or smoking objects.
- Do not use if any of its openings are blocked.
- Do not store the appliance in direct sunlight or in high humidity conditions.
- Do not use this appliance outdoors.
- Do not use any damaged accessories or adaptors.
- Do not use any parts/accessories or adaptors other than those supplied with this appliance, as this
 may cause damage.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Do not use the appliance if it has been dropped or if there are visible signs of damage.
- **Do not** use the adaptor to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not remove from the adaptor from the mains power supply by pulling the cord; switch off and remove the plug by hand.
- Do not expose the appliance to rain.
- Do not operate the appliance with wet hands.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Only use with provided power adapter.
- Use of an extension power cord is not allowed.
- Always ensure that the appliance has cooled fully after use before performing any cleaning or user maintenance.
- Switch off the appliance and disconnect it from the mains power supply before changing or fitting accessories
- Take care when equipping accessories with rotating parts as this could cause entrapment.
- This appliance is intended for domestic use only. It should not be used for commercial purposes.

Battery Safety

• If the battery pack becomes exhausted, it should be removed from the product to avoid leakage.

- If any part is damaged due to human error, only a qualified electrician can repair it. Please note the




- 1. Prevent unintentional starting ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting pack, picking up, or carrying the appliance.
- Carrying the appliance with your finger on the switch or energizing appliance that have the switch on invites accidents.
- 2. Disconnect the battery pack from the appliance before making any adjustments changing accessories or storing appliance.
- Such preventive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the appliance accidentally.
- 3. Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.
- 4. Use appliances only with specifically designated battery packs. Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
- 5. When battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objects, that can make a connection from one terminal
- Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.



Package Checklist





Motorized Cleaner Head:

Can be connected to the metal tube for daily cleaning on the floor or carpet, or to the main motor for cleaning the trunk.



Stiff Roller Brush:

Can be installed into the cleaner head; ideal for both hard floors or carpets.



Mini Motorized Cleaner Head:

Perfect for picking up hair or dust mite from fabric surface like sofa, mattresses, bed and pillows, etc.



Long Crevice:

For corners and other hard-to-reach places; Can be connected to the metal tube to clean spider web on the ceilings.



2-in-1 Brush:

Can be switched into a brush or a wide crevice; Suitable for fabric surface and corners.



2-in-1 Cleaning Gadget:


The blade end can be used to cut off hair wrapping around roller brush, while the other brush end be used to clean dirt inside dustbin, strainer or cleaner head.



Assembly & Combinations


To assemble the powerful cordless stick vacuum cleaner, please follow the instructions as shown.





Ensure a tight connection of the whole machine by a clear sound of click in each step. If you want to disassemble the vacuum, just press the release button on each part.

If you want to connect it with other attachments and work in different situations, please follow the **COMBINATION** instructions below.



Ready to Use

After assembly, the cordless vacuum is ready to work.

- 1. Press the power switch to turn on the vacuum.
- 2. Press the +/- button to switch among the three power modes.

	High	Medium	Low
Suction	Up to 25K pa	Up to 15Kpa	Up to 8K pa
Runtime	Up to 15 minutes	Up to 35 minutes	Up to 60 minutes

Runtime may vary in different situations. When vacuuming debris or particles in large size, it might decrease the runtime due to the heavy cleaning tasks.




When dust reaches MAX labeled on the dust cup, please empty the dust cup before going on.




Charging

The battery could be charged only when connected to the main motor. And it is suggested not to disassemble the battery from the main motor regularly.


* It will take about 5 hours to fully charge the battery.






- * The machine cannot be turned on during charging.

Daily Maintenance

In order to ensure a maximum performance of the vacuum, it is strongly recommended to maintain its components regularly.


Clean Non-electricity Part of the Main Motor:

- 1. Turn off the vacuum before cleaning.
- 2. Wipe the surface with a clean cloth.
- 3.Be cautious not to get water into the inner part of the main motor.
- * Do not place the vacuum cleaner under direct sunlight or in wet place after cleaning.

Clean Detachable Roller Brush:

There will be alert on LED Display if the roller brush gets tangled or stuck. Please clean it in time.

- 1. Unlock the side lock on the bottom side of the cleaner head.
- 2. Remove the side cover and take out the roller brush.
- 3. Use the 2-in-1 cleaning gadget to clean it.





Clean Stainless Steel Strainer & Filter




- 1. Please check and clean the Stainless Steel Strainer/HEPA regularly.
- 2. Please clean the filter in time if the suction performance decline.
- 3. Please replace the filter/HEPA if it is broken or it cannot maintain the suction performance of the vacuum cleaner.
- 4. Please do not bend or squeeze the HEPA.





- 1. Detach the main motor and dust cup, take out the HEPA in the main motor and the filter component in the dust cup. Hold the strainer, rotate the filter holder, then take out the sponge filter.
- 2. If they are too dirty, you could wash the strainer and the sponge with cool water, and clean the HEPA with the cleaning brush.
- 3. Ensure the strainer and sponge are completely dry before refitting.




Filter Installation









03. Make sure the NOTCH on the filter holder fits into the slot perfectly.




04. Make sure the strainer keep vertical to the dust cup cover.



05. Put the HEPA filter into the main motor.



06. Connect the dust cup to the main motor.

Troubleshooting

Q1. Machine stops working or doesn't work		
A1. Low battery or no battery power. A2. There is blockage.	1. Charge the battery.	
A3. Roller brush is tangled by hair.	Remove the blockage in the fitler or the retractable metal tube.	
	3. Clean the roller and also remove the side covers of the roller to remove the tangled hair.	

Q2. Roller brush stops spinning	
A1. Roller brush is tangled by hair.A2. Something wrong with the metal tube.	 Clean the roller brush and remove the hair. Please contact us for after-sale service.

Q3. Weak suction power	
A1. Dustbin, strainer or filter is full of dust.	Clean the dustbin, strainer or filter, replace the filter if necessary.
A2. The strainer or filter is not installed.	2. Install the strainer and filter.
A3. There is blockage.A4. Roller brush is tangled by hair.	3&4. Clean the roller and also remove the side covers of the roller to remove the tangled hair.

Q4. Abnormal motor sound	
A1. There is blockage.A2. Something wrong with the main motor or the mini motorized cleaner head.	 Remove the blockage. Please contact us for after-sale service.

Q5. Battery cannot be charged	
A1. Wrong adaptor is used.A2. Connection between power cord and battery is loose.	 Use the correct adaptor offered by UMLo. Make sure the power cord is plugged tightly.
