












SHOWER PARTS IDENTIFICATION DIAGRAM












The product is equipped with G1/2 specifications connectors or interfaces, and it is recommended that users use G1/2 specifications connectors or interfaces.



- 8. After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clear water to remove any cleaner residue.
- 9. Soap and shampoo residue can also cause damage to the product. Rinse well with clean water after use.
- 10. If the surface is already damaged, harsh cleaning materials will cause further damage.
