CLEANING THE FILTERS

To clean filters, rinse them with water only. A low all filters to air-dry completely for at least 24 Fears before reinstalling to prevent liquid from being drawn into electric parts.

Clean the pre-motor filters at least once a month and post-motor. Her at least once a year. Tap off loose dirt between washes when needed. More frequent cleaning may somet may be necessary with heavy use. Cleaning the litters regularly helps maintain your vacuum's cleaning performance.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT use soop when deening the filters. Use water only.





Checking for Blocksgoe in the Floor Nazzle:

TROUBLESHOOTING

A WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn off power and remove the battery before servicing.

Vacuum is not picking up debris. No suction or light suction. Mozzle light is red. (Refer to Checking for Blockages section for more information.)

- Remove any string, cannot fibers, or heir that may be wrapped around the brushroll.
- Check connection between hendheld vectuum and wand for blockegee; dear. blockages if required.
- Check clog access th wand for any blockages and clear any debris.
- Check filters to see if they need cleaning. Follow instructions for ringing and. completely an-drying the fitters before reinserting in the vacuum.

Vacuum lifts area rugs.

- Make sure you are not enceding boost mode. Take care when veguaning area rups or risks with delicately sown edges.
- * Turn off the unit to disengage the brushfoll and restart with the power/selector Secretary.

Brushroll dose not spin.

- . Immediately curryoff the vaccium. Remose any blockages before turning the vaccium back on Make sure the handheld vacuum is tilted back for enough for the brushroll.
- If the floor novelether has headights and they are not if immeded, there is a connection. issue between the handheld vacuum, wand, and nozzle. Try disconnecting and reattaching the ewors.

Vacuum tums off on its own.

There are several possible reasons for the vacuum turning off on its own, including prockages, battery issues, and overheating, if vacuum turns off on its own, perform the following steps

- 1. Jum on the vaccom and check the battery and cator lights boated on the bendheld. portion of the vacuum. If recharging is needed, plug in while vacuum is in the offposition.
- 2. Empty dust our and clear filters (See Emptying the Dust Cup and Clearing the Filters sections):
- Check wand, accessories, and injet openings and remove any blockages.
- 4. Allow unit and bettery to cool for at least 45 minutes, unit they return to room. temperature.
- 5. Restart with power/selector switch.

Battery Indicator Lights on handheld vacuum are fleshing.
