User Manual



Main Light Button: Press the button to turn on / tum off the main light.

main light CCT button : Press K- ,main light color temperature decreasing at 4levels: $6500 \, \text{K}$, $5000 \, \text{K}$, $4000 \, \text{K}$, $2700 \, \text{K}$.

Press and hold K- button for stepless decrease color temperture changing.

main light CCT button : Press K+,mainlight color temperature increasing at 4levels:2700K,4000K,5000K,6500K

Press and hold K+ button for stepless increase color temperturechanging.



main light dimming button : Press dimming - button, main light brightness decreasing at 7levels 100%-80%-60%-40%-20%-10%-1%. Press and hold dimming- button for stepless decrease dimming

main light dimming button: Press dimming + button, main light brightness increasing at 7levels 1%,10%,20%,40%,60%,80%,100%.

Mood Light Button:

Press the button to turn on / tum off the mood light.

mood light dimming button : Press dimming - button, mood light brightness decreasing at 7levels 100%-80%-60%-40%-20%-10%-1%. Press and hold dimming- button for stepless decrease dimming

main light dimming button: Press dimming + button, main light brightness increasing at 7levels 1%,10%,20%,40%,60%,80%,100%.

Press and hold dimming+ button for stepless increase dimming

Press M button, mood light to sequentially illuminate in red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet, and music rhythm mode in a continuous loop.
