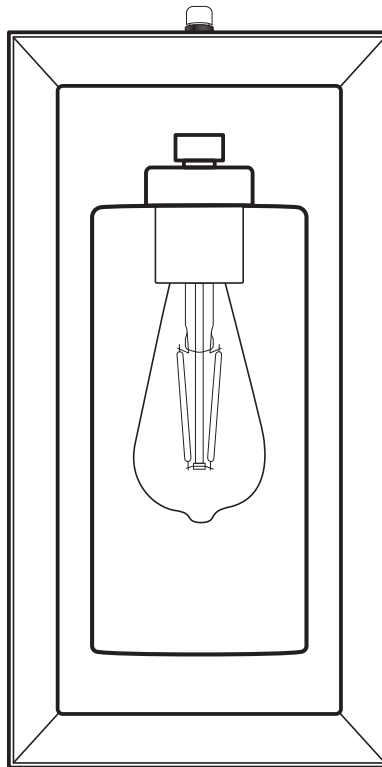

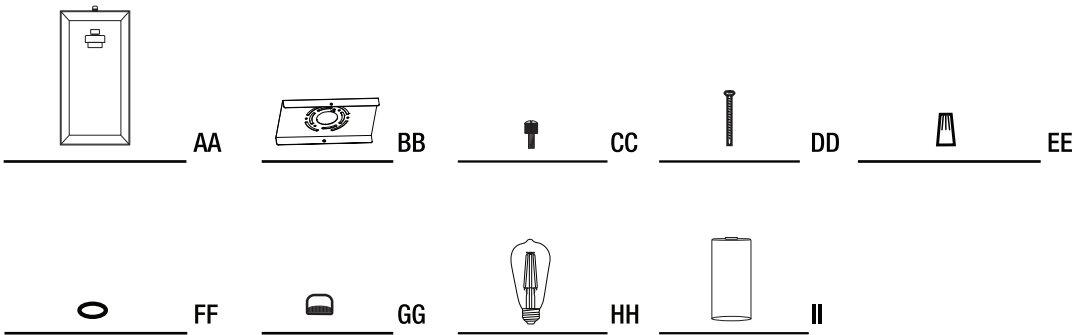

IMPORTANT WIRING INFORMATION

Always follow the recommended wire strip lengths and wiring combinations when connecting wires.

Hold stripped ends next to each other and align frayed strands (do not twist wires).

Push wires firmly into wire nut. Using your fingers, twist wire nut clockwise until tight. Check for tightness by pulling wires.

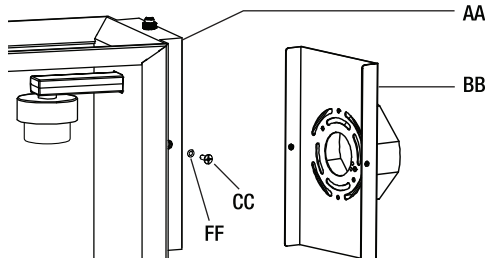
Installation

1 Turning Off Power

Turn off the power at the switch and fuse box or circuit breaker box.

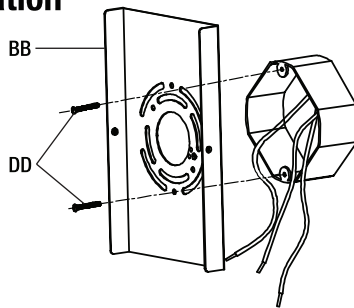
2 Prepare Pre-Installed Mounting Plate

Unscrew the two (2) thumb screws (CC) remove the washers (FF) and keep them for later. Remove the mounting plate (BB).



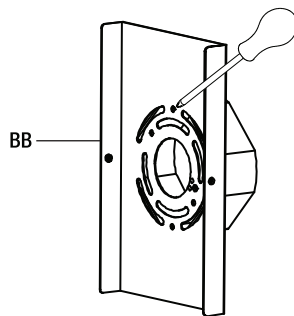
3 Mounting Plate Installation

Mount mounting plate (BB) to outlet box by inserting the two J-box mounting screws (DD) through slots in mounting plate (BB).



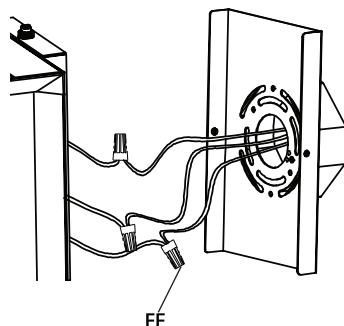
4 Adjust Mounting Plate

Position the mounting plate (BB) for fixture mounting screws to horizontal position. Tighten both middle screws on crossbar (BB) to hold the crossbar in place.



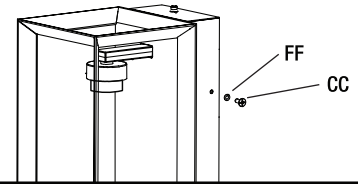
5 Connect Wires

Lift the fixture to the outlet box. Using the wire nuts (EE) provided, connect the green ground wire from the fixture to the house ground. Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral supply wire and connect the black fixture wire to the live wire.



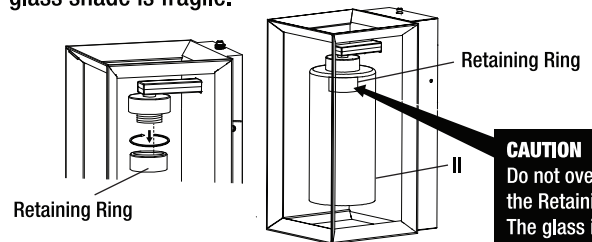
6 Mount the Fixture Body

Mount the fixture onto the mounting plate and use the two thumb screws (CC) with rubber washers (FF) to secure the fixture. Align the screws through the openings of the fixture and hand tighten to the mounting plate.



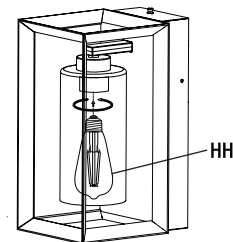
7 Install Glass Shade

Turn the retaining ring counter-clockwise to remove. Insert the glass shade (II) into the lamp holder and hold. Screw the retaining ring onto the lamp holder by turning it clockwise until the glass shade is securely in place. Do not over-tighten. The glass shade is fragile.



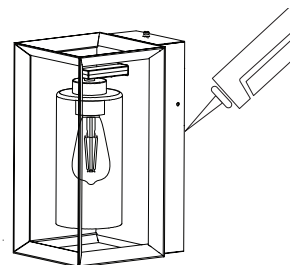
8 Install Light Bulb

Screw in provided LED light bulb (HH). Make sure you're firmly holding the housing while you do this.



9 Seal Fixture

Once fixture is secured, to prevent water or moisture from entering into the fixture apply a silicone sealant to the top side, side edges of the fixture and the mounting surface (not required at the bottom side of the fixture).



10 Turn Power On

Turn on the power at the switch and fuse box or circuit breaker box.

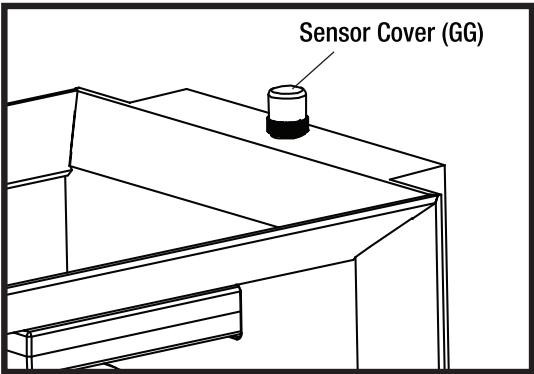
IMPORTANT: Follow the GFCI Operating Instructions and ensure the TEST and RESET buttons are working properly.

Dusk to Dawn

- The light will turn on at dusk.
- The light will remain on through the night until dawn. At dawn, the light will turn off.
- The light will remain off through the day until dusk.

 **NOTE:** To make sure this function works properly, always keep the wall switch in the “ON” position (including daytime).

 **NOTE:** A sensor cover (GG) is provided which can be used to block out light and bypass the sensor. This will keep the light continuous on and fixture can be controlled to turn on/off through the wall switch or a master photocell.



Troubleshooting

If this fixture fails to operate properly, use the guide below to diagnose and correct the problem:

- Verify that power is turned on at switch and breaker.
- Verify that fixture is wired properly.
- Verify that line voltage is correct.
- Test if photocontrol works properly.

The photocontrol in this fixture is designed to turn on fixture at low light levels.

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	CORRECTIVE ACTION
1. Light does not come on after dark	1. No power is being delivered to the fixture. 2. Another light source is causing the Outdoor Lantern to think it is daylight. 3. Wiring inside electrical box came loose. 4. Ambient light levels too high. 5. The GFCI TEST button has tripped. Green indicator light is OFF.	1. Check that circuit breaker and/or wall switchpower is on. 2. Turn off surrounding lights. 3. Turn power off to the fixture and check supply wire for any loose wiring. 4. Press the GFCI RESET button. (See NOTE under the GFCI Operating Instructions)
2. Light stays on	1. Sensor cover is placed on Dusk-to-Dawn sensor. 2. Dusk-to-Dawn sensor is dirty.	1. Remove sensor cover from Dusk-to-Dawn sensor. 2. Clean Dusk-to-Dawn sensor with a damp cloth.
3. Outdoor Lantern cycles ON and OFF continuously	1. Dusk-to-Dawn sensor is sensing reflected light from the Outdoor Lantern.	1. Ensure Outdoor Lantern is not in front of any reflective surfaces.

GFCI OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This fixture is equipped with a GFCI receptacle, a GFCI receptacle is different from conventional receptacles. In the event of a ground fault, a GFCI will trip and quickly stop the flow of electricity to prevent serious injury.

Definition of a ground fault:
Instead of following its normal safe path, electricity passes through a person's body to reach the ground. For example, a defective appliance can cause a ground fault. A GFCI receptacle does NOT protect against circuit overloads, short circuits, or shocks. For example, you can still be shocked if you touch bare wires while standing on a non-conducting surface, such as a wood floor.

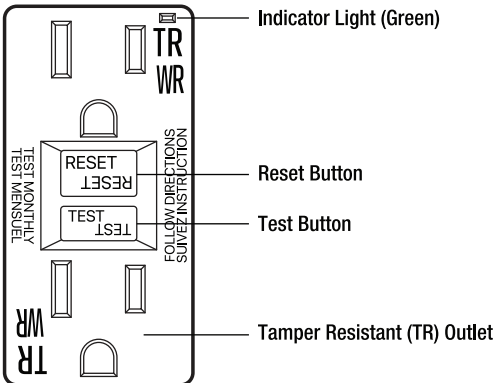
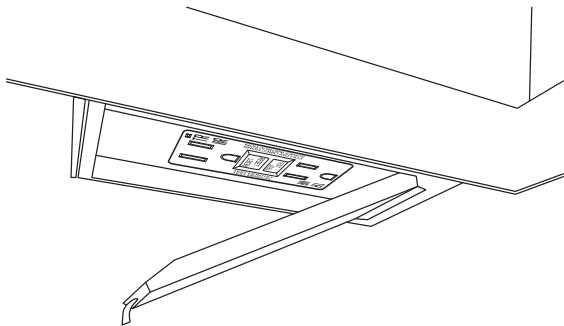
- TR** : Tamper Resistant mechanism stops access to outlet contacts unless a two-prong plug is inserted.
- TEST BUTTON** : Press the TEST button to test the device, which will stop the flow of electricity, and the RESET button will pop out.
- RESET BUTTON** : Press the RESET button fully to restore the power, the green indicator LED will be on.

Outlet Rating: 120V 60Hz 15A max.

 **NOTE:** Press the TEST button (then RESET button) every month to assure proper operation. If the Status Indicator Light does not turn Green when the RESET button is depressed and then released, or the GFCI cannot be reset, it must be replaced.



WARNING: In order to avoid water accumulation in GFCI box on rainy days, always keep the GFCI box closed.
