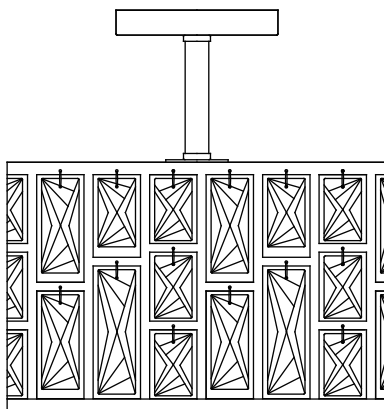

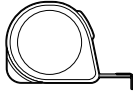
PLANNING INSTALLATION

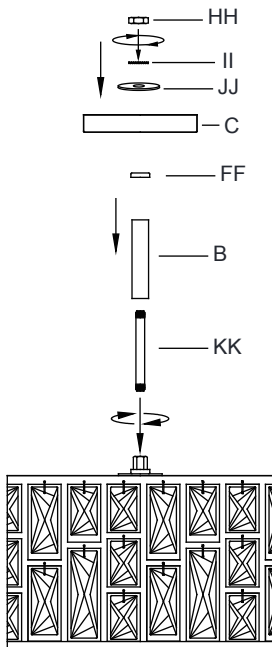

Installation

1 Installing the fixture body

- Carefully unpack the fixture. Lay out all the parts on a clean surface.
- Unravel the supply power and ground wires and pass them through the center holes of the stem (KK) into the coupling at the center of the fixture body (A).
- Twist the stem (KK) onto the top of the fixture body. Then place the bushing (B) over the stem (KK).
- Place the flat collar (FF), followed by the canopy (C), plain washer (JJ) and lock washer (II). Then secure this assembly in place using the hex nut (HH).

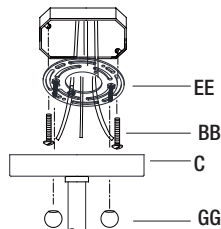


2 Installing the crossbar



WARNING: To reduce the risk of electrical shock, turn the power off at the main fuse box before installation.

- Remove the crossbar (EE) from the canopy (C) by loosening the two ball nuts (GG) on the canopy (C).
- Attach the crossbar (EE) to the junction box (not included) with the outlet box screws (BB).

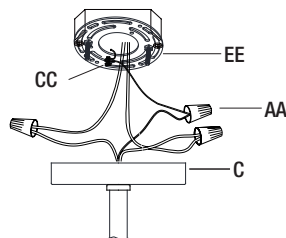


3 Connecting the wires



NOTE: Always use wire nuts (AA) (included) to connect wires and push all excess wires and connections back into the junction box.

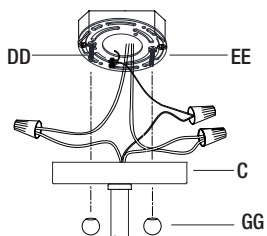
- Push all slack fixture wire through the canopy (C) and into the outlet box. Trim the excess fixture wire, leaving a minimum of 6 in. hanging out of the outlet box.
- Connect the ground wire from the branch circuit to the ground screw (CC) on the crossbar (EE).
- Connect the wires as follows:



WHITE WIRE	WHITE WIRE
FROM HOUSE	FROM FIXTURE
BLACK WIRE	BLACK WIRE
FROM HOUSE	FROM FIXTURE
GROUND WIRE	GROUND WIRE
FROM HOUSE	FROM CANOPY

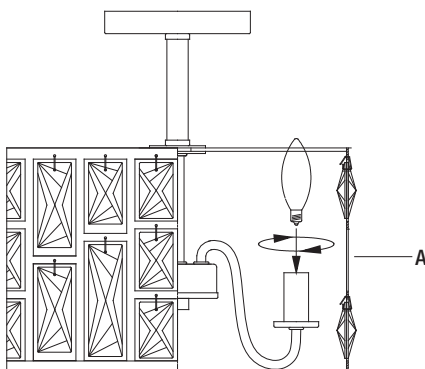
4 Installing the fixture body

- Install the canopy (C) to the crossbar (EE) by securing the two ball nuts (GG) to the two mounting screws (DD).



5 Installing the bulbs

- Install three 60W max. B10 bulbs (not included) to the socket of the fixture body (A).



Care and Cleaning

- Clean the light fixture carefully with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
□ The bulb will not light.	□ The bulb is burned out.	□ Replace the bulb with a new 60W max. B10 bulb.
	□ The power is off.	□ Ensure that the power supply is turned on.
	□ The circuit breaker is off.	□ Ensure that the circuit breaker is set to the ON position.
□ The fuse blows or the circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	□ There are too many items on one circuit.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">□ Unplug the other items on the circuit.□ Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-800-986-3460.
