## KEY OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Power Key

Long press this button for 3 seconds to power on; Long press for 3 seconds again to power off. Find the Bluetooth name "SOAR ANC" in the search list to connect it to your mobile or other Bluetooth device.

Short press to Open and Off the ANC

### + Key

Long press to increase volume. Short press to skip to next song.

### - Key

Long press to decrease volume. Short press for previous song.

### Play/Pause Key

Press this button to play/pause the music.

### Call

Press the **Play/Pause** button to hang up.  
Long press the **Play/Pause** button to reject call.  
Quick double press the **Play/Pause** button to redial last number.

You can also use the wired function by using the 3.5 mm jack to connect a mobile device or computer to the headphones.
