


# Power Recliner Chair Owner's Manual




Make sure that the armrest /the back support connector is fully aligned with the chair base connector when inserting it, and then press down firmly until you hear a "click" sound to complete.




## STEP3

No. (1) wires from the backrest and chair base with same color connect together.





## How to use the massage remote?



- 1. POWER: Turn on/off remote control.
- **2. HEAT:** Turn on/off the heating function for the backrest. (Heating function works with vibration separately.)
- 3. MODE: Set different massage modes.
- **4. TIMER:** The timer can be set in fixed time 10/20/30 minutes.
- **5. POINTS:** Control massage points (back, lumber, thigh) individually.
- **6. INTENSITY:** Select the strength of the massage function (low, medium, high).

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

The following troubleshooting FAQs should summarize what you need to know about your recliner chair. If at any time you do not feel comfortable performing the troubleshooting steps listed in this manual, please contact Mcombo Customer Support for service.

Questions	Questions Answers
What if the reclining function of my recliner chair does not operate at all?	<ul> <li>Make sure all the connections of the chair are secured.</li> <li>Check if the RED light on the swith and the GREEN light on the power adapter on the bottom of the base are on.</li> <li>Check all the electrical cords are not crimped or pinched.</li> <li>Make sure the GREEN light of the recline remote goes on.</li> </ul>
What if the massage and heat do not work?	<ul> <li>Check all the electrical cords are not crimped or pinched.</li> <li>Make sure the GREEN light on the power adapter on the bottom of the base is on.</li> <li>Check if the GREEN light on the USB charge ports goes on.</li> <li>Make sure the lights of the massage remote go on.</li> </ul>
What if the USB charge ports do not work?	<ul> <li>Make sure the massage and heat are both effective.</li> <li>Make sure the USB cable coming out of the right armrest is properly connected;</li> <li>Check if the GREEN light on the USB charge ports goes on.</li> </ul>
What if the armrest falls apart from seat?	<ul> <li>Ensure the two connections on each armrest are all inserted onto the seat tightly.</li> <li>Check the brackets of armrest and base to ensure there is no defects.</li> </ul>
What if my recliner chair makes a clicking noise?	<ul> <li>Check to make sure the chair frame, motor and wiring are intact.</li> <li>Make sure the weight capacity of 300 lbs has not been exceeded.</li> </ul>
What if my recliner chair tilted to one side?	<ul> <li>Check the brackets of backrest are installed into seat tightly.</li> <li>Make sure the frame at the bottom of recliner chair is in a good condition without any distortion.</li> <li>Use recliner chair on the flat carpet, not smooth floor.</li> </ul>

**IMPORTANT:** If the recliner still does not operate properly, please contact the Mcombo Customer Support for help and never attempt to make any repairs or adjustments yourself.

### **PRODUCT CARE**

Dust regularly with a soft, dry cloth to prevent soil build-up. Keep away from heat to avoid glazing, melting or scorching. Use a professional cleaning service to clean the fabric.
