

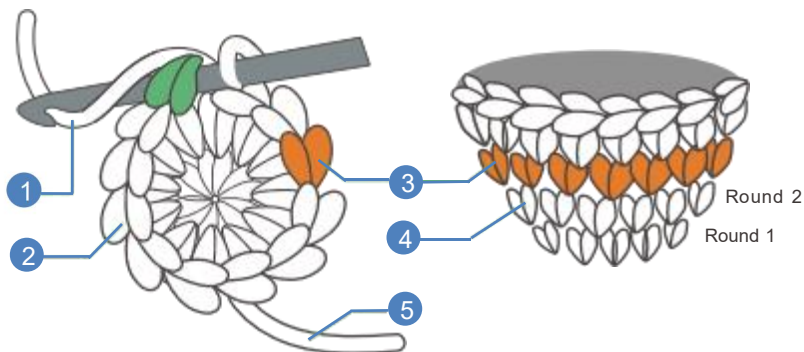


Step-by-step crochet tutorial

This pattern uses US terminology, here you can find the abbreviations that you will need:

MR	Magic ring	CH	Chain stitch
SC	Single crochet	BLO	Back loops only
INC	Increase	FLO	Front loops only
DEC	Decrease	HDC	half double crochet
SL	Slip stitch	DC	double crochet
3sc in 1st		3 single crochet in 1 stitch	

Learn about Crochet



- 1 Working yarn**
Yarn connected to the ball of yarn.
- 2 Top loops of a stitch**
Where you usually insert the hook, to start the next stitch.
- 3 Single crochet stitch**
A series of crochet stitches in a circle.
This illustrated crochet piece is made of 4 rounds.
- 4 Round**
End of yarn not connected to the ball of yarn.
- 5 Yarn tail (end)**
The main stitch used in amigurumi.

- Do not join rounds unless stated, work in a continuous spiral
- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round

Body

Round	Pattern	Stitch
R1	8SC in MR	8
R2	8INC	16
R3	16SC	16
R4	(SC,INC)*8	24
R5	24SC	24
R6	(7SC,INC)*3	27
R7	27SC	27
R8	(4SC,INC,4SC)*3	30
R9	BLO:30SC	30
R10-R11	30SC	30
R12	(4SC,DEC,4SC)*3	27
R13	BLO:(7SC,DEC)*3	24
R14	(SC,DEC,SC)*6	18
R15	(SC,DEC)*6	12
Reserve 10CM of yarn and close the bottom with a suture needle.		
R9	FLO:[SL,(HDC,DC in 1st),HDC]*10,SL	30

Wings*2

Round	Pattern	Stitch
R1	Chain 2	2
	Find the 2nd space from the hook,work: INC, CH	2
R2	Turn: 2INC,CH	4
R3	Turn: 4SC,CH	4
R4	Turn: DEC, 2SC,CH	3
R5	Turn: DEC, SC,CH	2
R6	Turn: DEC	1
Crochet along 3 sides to smoothen out edges		
R7	CH,5SC on the 1st side	5
R8	INC on last row	2
R9	5SC in the 3rd side	5
Leave 20cm of yarn for stitching,cut the yarn,repeat the process to crochet two pieces.		

Nose:

Round	Pattern	Stitch
R1	3SC in MR	3
R2	3INC	6
R3	6SC	6
R4	(2SC,INC)*2	8
R5	8SC	8
Leave 15cm of yarn waiting to be stitched.		

Hat

Round	Pattern	Stitch
R1	6SC in MR	6
R2	BLO:6INC	12
R3	12SC	12
R4	12INC	24
Leave 20cm of yarn waiting to be stitched.		

Sew up

Eyes	Insert safety eyes between rounds 6 and 7,spacing them 5 stitches apart.
Nose	Sew the nose to the body that is right in the middle of the 6th-8th round.
Wings	Sew the wings on lines 8th-12th rounds,on both side parts.
Hat	Sew the hat to the top of the body.
Claw	Use sutures to make three stitches on both sides of the bottom.
