

Instructions for Use: BOHS Montessori Bead Stair

Product Overview

The **BOHS Montessori bead stair set** is a hands-on math tool designed for children ages 3-6. It includes color-coded bead bars and a wooden tray with numbered slots. Use this material to teach counting, sequencing, and early math skills at home or in the classroom.

Safety Notice

• Supervision Required: Beads are small parts and may pose a choking hazard. Use BOHS bead stairs only under adult supervision.

Getting Started

1. Unpack and Check:

- o Remove all pieces of your bead stair set from packaging.
- Confirm you have bead bars for each number (1-10).

2. Setup:

- o Place the wooden tray on a table or flat surface.
- o Arrange bead bars in numerical (and color) order.

How to Use

1. Counting



• Invite your child to place bead bars in order, counting aloud.

2. Matching Numbers

• Ask the child to find the bead bar that matches a given number or slot.

3. Sequencing

• Mix up the bars and challenge your child to put them in order.

4. Exploring Addition

• Combine two bead bars and count total beads together.

5. Fine Motor Skills

• Encourage placing and removing bars to strengthen hand and finger muscles.

Tips and Maintenance

- Portable: The BOHS bead stair set is small and easy to carry for travel or outings.
- Cleaning: Wipe with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Keep dry.
- Storage: Store all bead bars in the tray to prevent loss.
- Note: Tray and bead bars are small—keep away from babies and toddlers.

Troubleshooting

- Color differences: Some sets may show slight color shade variations.
- Size: The tray measures about 4.3 x 7 inches; pieces are designed for small hands.

Recommendations

- Highly recommended by educators for young children's math learning.
