Everyday Cleaning

Caesarsure™ surfaces require very little maintenance to stay clean and shiny. To keep your Caesarsure™ surfaces clean, use Caesarsure™ Cream Cleanser and Sealant on the surface with warm soapy water for mild soiling and a clean damp cloth for use on varnished Caesarsure™ Spacedecor™. Do not use the cloth you use for greasy dishes, as it may transfer oil and other contaminants to the Caesarsure™ surface.

As Caesarsure™ surfaces are ageing, they may require polishing or sealing. However, attempt to refresh the surface and avoid over-polishing or over-sealing when possible.

Remove pollutants materials (e.g. fuel, gum and tar) as quickly as you can away from exposure to a sharp edge. If there are any grey metal marks on the surface, use a small amount of Caustic Soda® from the green or blue tub, once space size of JMTM's tubbing, gently rub over the marking thoroughly once with warm water then use the Caustic Soda® once again generally once, so as you feel better when the grey's tubbing marks, but care should be taken as some products are corrosive to your skin and clothes.

Remove any tubbing marks which is all right to be removed, more can be done frequently Asked Questions on contact, size of JMTM's 19" x 19" for further advice.

Tough? Yes. Indestructible? No.

As with any surface, Caustic Soda® can be permanently damaged by exposure to certain chemicals and solvents that are deemed to be essential for your business. For all use products that contain hydrocarbons or methylene chloride, such as acetone, benzene or stronger. Avoid all contact with any gas pressure or other liquids. Remove all chemicals that have high alkalinity (pH over 12). Should the surface be accidentally exposed to any of these damaging products, immediately telephone your local fire department for effect.

Do Concrete Finishes require extra maintenance?

Caustic Soda® Concrete Finishes require the same same and same maintenance as polished surfaces, never require sealing and are smoke free.

Remove the Concrete finish thoroughly to remove marks as well as the polished finish, meaning more regular maintenance may be required using the Caustic Soda® Spill Cleaner for daily use and Caustic Soda® from the green and JMTM's tubbing. JMTM's Scrubbing Machine can be used to remove dirt and oil from the surface, clean up the instructions. Most importantly, thoroughly use the Caustic Soda® from off the green.

It is extremely important that a Caustic Soda® Concrete finish surface is only ever wiped down using a clean cloth for the first time. Wipe down with a soft long-handled brush as they import oil and other contaminants on the concrete finish surface.

Heat Resistance

Caesars can™ is made from an ultra-dense, naturally non-porous material. Caesars can™ can be damaged by sudden and rapid surface temperature changes. A good rule of thumb is that, if you're hand cannot touch the side of heat of an item, then avoid touching the surface for more than a few seconds, then the heat source is too hot. Therefore, we always recommend placing hot pots, oven trays and frypans straight from the oven or straight onto a wooden chopping board or mats. We also recommend that all electrical cooking appliances such as electric frypans and slow cookers are also placed on a wooden chopping board.



Food Preparation

We always recommend cutting on an appropriate, ultra-dense and heavy-duty on the counters or Caesars can™ surface to avoid cutting surface stains or damaging the surface of your bench top.

For everyday marks and soils



First, wipe away any residue.



Simply drag and wipe your surface clean.



Once finished, buff with a clean, dry cloth.

For removal of stubborn marks & dried soils

To give your Caesarstone® surface a thorough clean or for removal of extra stubborn marks or soils, we recommend using Caesarstone® Cream Cleanser and a soft Scotch-Brite® Non-Scratch Foam Scrub which can be used without damaging the stone. We suggest using this cleaning process regularly depending on the amount of traffic, use and surface application.



1

1. Rinse the RME Foam Scrub with warm water.



2

2. Apply 1-2 teaspoons of Caesarstone® Cream Cleanser directly to the foam scrub on the scrubbers side.

3. Gently squeeze to create a thick foam ether.



Gently clean in a circular motion.



Use a flat, clean hand.



Be cautious not to apply excessive pressure or rub in one spot for too long.



Leave the layered soap mix on the surface for up to two minutes.

Remove all excess suds, rinsing the surface with warm water and a microfibre cloth or soft clean towel.

Rinse and repeat several times to ensure all excess suds are removed.

Once finished, buff with a clean dry cloth.

The 3M Scotch-Brite Non-Scratch Foam Scrub can be squeezed & rinsed out, dried and used again for cleaning the Caesarstone® surface.

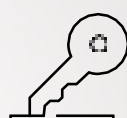

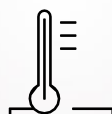
