
How do I upgrade the firmware manually on my DWR-910M 4G LTE USB Mobile Router?

- 1 Visit the D-Link support page and select your country at https://support.dlink.com/globaldirectory.aspx. Then, look for the latest firmware version of your specific device model and download the file on your computer.
- 2 Plug your MIFI into the USB port on your computer or connect to it wirelessly.

Note: To avoid disruption during the firmware upgrade, it is advised that you use a wired connection

3 Open a web browser (such as Google Chrome, Firefox, or Safari) In the address bar, type in (URL: http://192.168.0.1) and then press Enter.

You will then be prompted to enter your device username and password. By default, the admin username and password are both "admin".



Note: If you cannot log in using the default admin password, you will need to hard reset the router to factory defaults.

4 Once logged in, Click **Router** at the upper right-hand side of the screen.







- 5 Click **Software Upgrade** on the left-hand side. Under Software Upgrade click on the **Browse** button and locate the .bin file downloaded in Step 1. Highlight the file by clicking on it once and then click **Open**.
- 6 Click on **Update** to upgrade firmware. It may take up to 30 seconds for the upgrade to complete. When the upgrade is complete, a confirmation window will appear, click **Continue** when it appears. The firmware is now upgraded.
