If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electric anito install the proper outlet. DO NOT modify the plug in any way.

AWARNING: Extension cords are not recommended for use with this product.

AWARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK OR INJURY:

- 1 A CAUTION: Blade assembly is sharp, handle with care. When handling the blade assembly, always hold by the base of the blade assembly.
- 2 A CAUTION: DO NOT blend hot liquids.
- 3 A CAUTION: 00 NOT process dry ingredients without adding liquid to the cup. This product is not intended for dry blending.
- 4 A CAUTION: 00 NOT use stainless steel cup accessory model XSKDWSS24 with blender.
- 5 A CAUTION: We do not recommend grinding in any of our Nutri Ninja® Cups.
- 6 To protect against electrical shock, do not submerge the appliance or allow the power cord to come into contact with water or any other liguid.
- 7 **DO NOT** allow young children to operate the appliance or use as a toy. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 8 Never leave an appliance unattenced when in use.
- 9 Furnithe appliance Offland remove the power condition the electrical outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts and before cleaning. To unplug, graspithe oldgrand pull from the electrical outlet. Never bull from the power cord.
