Connect the modem to the internet port on the router.


Step 3:

Once the light on the router is solid purple open the Linksys app and tap on Launch setup.



Step 6: The app will start to search for your router.




If the router is not found, you may be prompted to select what type of device you are setting up, tap on **Mesh Wi-Fi Router (MR Series)**.

Check the light on the router. If it is blinking purple, tap on **Yes**, **it's Blinking Purple**. If the light on your router is not blinking purple, tap on **No**, **It's not Blinking Purple** to search again.




Step 8: The app will now check if your router has an internet connection.



NOTE: If you are using a mobile device that does not have a data plan, you will be prompted to connect to the router's default Wi-Fi name. The Wi-Fi name and password are located on the bottom of the router. This is a temporary connection only. Once you are connected to the default Wi-Fi name, go back to the app and tap on **Next** to continue.




Step 9: Create a Linksys server account or tap on **Log in here** to enter your existing account credentials.




Step 10: Personalize your Wi-Fi by creating a Wi-Fi name and password, tap on **Next**, and wait for your new Wi-Fi settings to apply.


Launch the Linksys app and select Set up a New Wi-Fi Network.


The app will start to search for the router.




