



Universal Intercom

Note: the audio source paired to **VOL+** button (Music or navigator's indications) remains in background to the

intercom communication opened between two people.




Note: to pair a second device in audio mono mode, repeat the same procedure but press **Vol-.**


UNIVERSAL INTERCOM PAIRING



Attention: you can pair a maximum of 3 intercom devices (Midland, OBI or other brand), one for each button. A new pairing on the same button overwrites the previous one.

INTERCOM FUNCTIONALITY

The "Intercom" communication allows you to talk to one person at a time, through any of the paired intercoms, or to talk to more than one intercom device at the same time (Conference mode).



Intercom communication one person at a time

When the intercom communication is already open to one person, first close it and only then open the Intercom communication to another person.



Conference mode

When the intercom communication already open to one person, just open the intercom to a second person without closing the first conversation. In Conference mode you can talk up to 4 people in a chain (Conference to 4). Each intercom device can have two communications open simultaneously.

Note: in the device with the Conference mode activated (intercorn open to other two devices), you can however receive a phone call from the device paired to Vol+ (the music in background and the device paired to Vol- will be termporarily disconnected and will be connected again when the second intercorn is closed).

INTERCOM FUNCTIONALITY

FUNCTIONS DESCRIPTION

Up button - Rider 2:

(Midland/OBI/Universal Intercom)



Control button - Rider 1 (Midland/OBI/ Universal Intercom) Down button - Rider 3 (Midland/OBI/ Universal Intercom)

Intercom functions are accessed by pressing twice the buttons corresponding to the pairings.

OPEN/CLOSE INTERCOM AND OBI MANUALLY



Note: to talk with Rider 2 or Rider 3 repeat the procedure but press the buttons corresponding to the pairings.

OPEN INTERCOM BY VOICE (VOX)



Note: the voice activation is possible only with the intercom paired to the **Control button-Rider 1** (VOX must be active)

TO OPEN/CLOSE UNIVERSAL INTERCOM



Note: to open/close the audio from **the different brand device**, use the **voice call** comand (for some models it is necessary to send the voice call twice).

INTERCOM FUNCTIONALITY

TO ENABLE/DISABLE VOX (Open Intercom by voice)



NOISE GATE ENABLE/DISABLE (Mutes microphone in absence of voice)




AGC ENABLE/DISABLE (volume automatic adjustement according to speed)




Voice assistant (Phone on Vol+)

Phone functions are accessed by pressing once on the buttons.

Note: if your phone is paired to Vol-, use the Down button.

ANSWERING/ENDING/REJECTING A CALL




Note: you can press any key.


MUSIC SHARE WITH PASSENGER
