

Storage Shelves Usage Instructions

1. Safety Precautions

- **Stable Placement:** Ensure the rack is placed on a flat, level surface to prevent tipping. Avoid positioning it near edges, high-traffic areas, or where it may be bumped accidentally.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute items evenly across the shelves to maintain balance. Do not overload individual shelves beyond their recommended capacity.
- **Handling:** When moving the assembled rack, grip it firmly from the sides to avoid shifting items or damaging the structure.

2. Assembly Steps

- **Prepare Parts:** Lay out all components (shelves, frames, screws, bolts, brackets) and verify against the included checklist to ensure nothing is missing.
- **Follow Instructions:** Use the provided tools to assemble the frame first, then attach each shelf to the designated slots. Tighten all screws securely to ensure stability.
- **Adjust Shelves:** Utilize the adjustable shelf feature to set heights according to your storage needs, ensuring each shelf is locked into place before use.

3. Usage Guidelines

- **Multipurpose Placement:** Use in kitchens for cookware and dry goods, garages for tools, pantries for groceries, bathrooms for linens, or closets for accessories.
- **Organize Efficiently:** Place frequently used items on lower shelves for easy access and bulkier items on upper shelves to save space.
- **Maintain Accessibility:** Keep the open-back design clear of obstructions to ensure quick visibility and retrieval of stored items.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- **Regular Cleaning:** Wipe wooden surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent; clean metal parts with a soft, dry cloth to prevent rust. Avoid abrasive cleaners that may scratch surfaces.
- **Check Stability:** Periodically inspect screws and brackets to ensure they remain tight. Tighten any loose components promptly.
- **Prevent Damage:** Avoid placing hot items directly on wooden shelves to prevent discoloration. Use coasters or heat-resistant mats if necessary.

5. Troubleshooting

- **Wobbly Structure:** If the rack is wobbly, check if all shelves are properly aligned and screws are fully tightened. Adjust as needed.

- **Shelf Misalignment:** If shelves do not sit level, reposition them using the adjustable slots until they are even.
