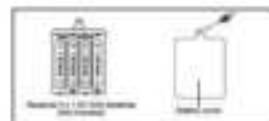
Diagram of the remote control with the following labels:

(Press the power button the most and press volume+/- and power to control the other buttons. Press the motion sensing button to control the other buttons.)

Abstract

1. Uncover the open battery compartment & K&F AA batteries.
2. Recharge battery cover.
Attacher's, remove battery after you have finished using your combi.



1. Disconnect the spare battery cable.
Insert 2 0.1.30 AA batteries.

2. Reconnect battery cable.
Afterward, remove batteries after you
have finished using your product.



NOTE: When you have selected the button to play a video and enable subtitles, you can adjust the volume of the video on the video toolbar. To switch the ON / OFF button to turn on the video, (the LED light of the video will be on the ON).

When you click again the video for a second time, it will change to a second state where video subtitles are not shown. You can control by clicking the ON / OFF button to switch on.

When you have finished playing with your video, switch the ON / OFF button to turn off the video.

NOTE: When your video is running from on screen, it will not be available from the panel buttons. (Since the buttons are continuously disabled, the buttons are not available to switch on).

By pressing the left and right arrow keys
your mind will start out on a roll.



By pressing the forward/backward button, the wheel will work forward/backward for a distance.
By pressing the action accelerator button, the wheel will enter action/acceleration mode. Press the forward/backward button, the wheel will accelerate forward/backward for a distance. Press the action/accelerator button again to return control mode.



Press the program button and your robot will enter program mode. Once in program mode, you can select the directional buttons or multi- & sensing button a series of times to create a movement program. The robot can be programmed with up to 50 actions. Press the program exit button to leave your robot ready for the new movement command that you created.

Voice record: Press the voice record button and your robot will enter voice record mode. Speak to the robot, then press the play/pause button. The robot will record what you say.



Value changes: These are some changes to the rules, the rules will enter value changes into. Based on the rules, the rules will generally reward what you say to other people.

Aftereffect: For better use, please keep away from infrared products, strong lights and signal sources when using the product.

Press the motion-sensing button and your music will enter motion-sensing mode. Once in motion-sensing mode, you can take full control of playback including pausing, fastforward, and even skipping through your playlist.
