#### Risk of injury and choking hazard for children!

Children can suffocate on packaging material and small parts. Children can injure themselves when handling the product. Never allow children to play with the packaging material and the product. Always store packaging material out of the reach of babies and small children. Always dispose of packaging material properly when it is not in use. #### Risk of cuts to the hands from sharp edges during assembly!

If the stand is moved without removing the loaded equipment, the stand may tip over and cause injuries and property damage. Always remove equipment from the stand before moving the stand.



#### Risk of injury due to tipping of stand on an unsuitable ground!

If the stand is placed on soft or uneven ground, it may overturn and cause injuries and property damage. Place the stand only on flat and solid ground.



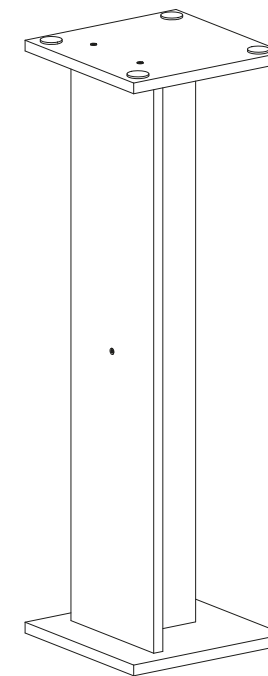
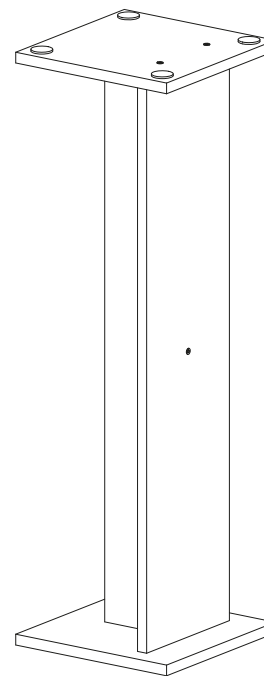
#### Risk of injury due to tipping of the stand from excessive loading!

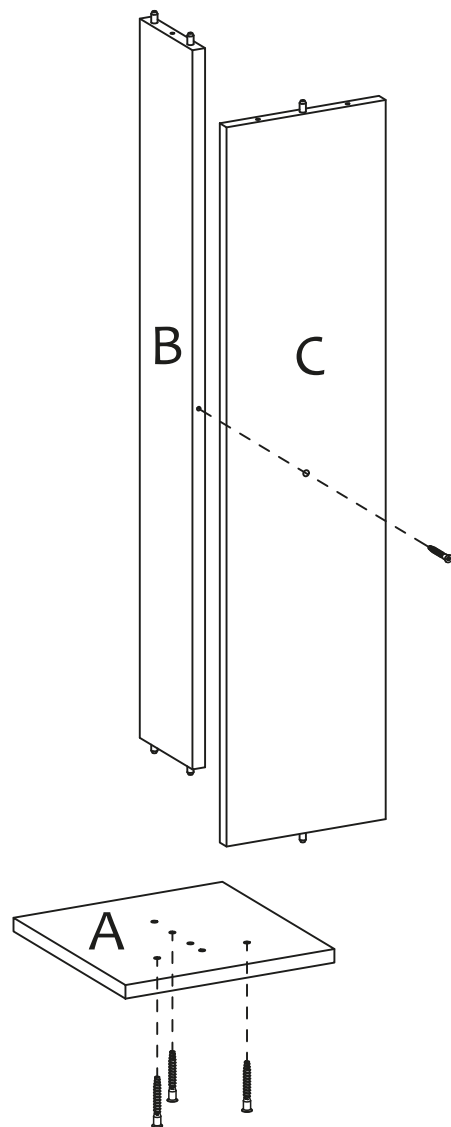
### STEP 1

Push wooden dowels type W in the appropriate holes



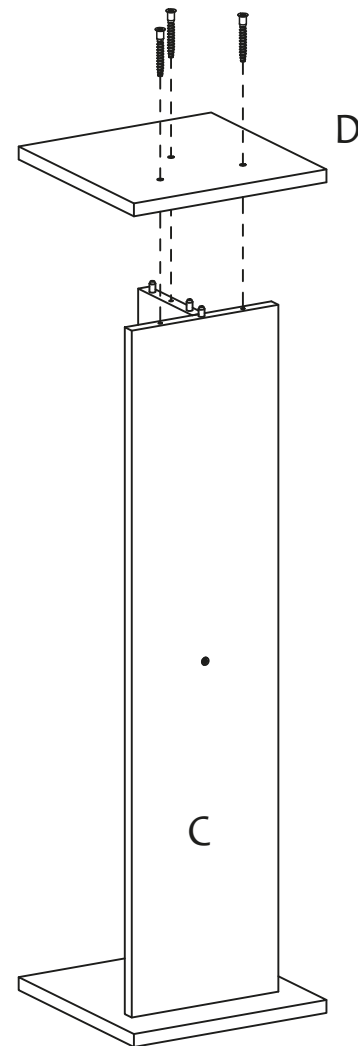

Use screws Type E



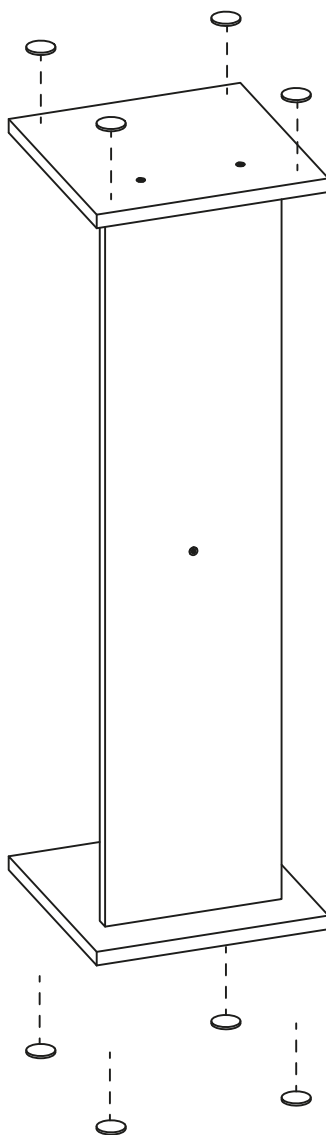
