
Bluetooth Speaker

User Manual

Bluetooth Pairing

Power on the device and enter Bluetooth mode to start pairing.

Turn on your cell phone Bluetooth, find "CX01" in the list and connect with the corresponding model. When the pairing is completed, the speaker color light stops flashing.



Button Function

- U Long press for about 3 seconds to turn on/off. Power on automatic TWS pairing, click this button to disconnect/ connect TWS
- Click this button to toggle the light: breathing/red/green/blue/
 purple/white/off light
- Click this button to previous song, long press volume down
- + Click this button for the next song, long press volume up
- Il Click this button to play/pause

Notes

- 1.Do not hit the main unit severely.
- 2.Do not touch benzene, thinner and other chemicals.
- 3.Keep away from magnetic and electric fields.
- 4.Please avoid direct light or heat generating appliances.
- 5.Do not disassemble, repair or remodel by yourself.

Warm Tip:

- ★ When the machine needs to be charged, please use a 5V-1A power adapter. And meet the power adapter that meets the requirements of CCC certification or national mandatory certification.
- ★ When not in use for a long time, it is recommended to charge the machine once a month!
- ★ The green light comes on when charging the machine off and goes off when fully charged.
- * The use of fast chargers is prohibited for this product.
