

2.1 Package Contents

2.2 Required Equipment

2.3 Remove Cell

- Turn off all electrical power to the power pack at the breakers.
- Ensure that the main filtration pump is off and will remain off for the duration of the procedure.




Figure 1. Operation of TruClear™ Lock Ring

- Turn the lock ring 1/4 turn counter clockwise. See Figure 1.




Figure 2. Remove Cell Assembly

- 4. Lift cell assembly straight out of the housing. See Figure 2.
- Disconnect the power cable from the power pack. See Figure 3.
- Dispose of old cell appropriately.

2.4 Install New Cell Assembly

- Place cell assembly straight down onto cell housing.
- 2. Turn the lock ring 1/4 turn clockwise to engage lock. See Figure 1.




Figure 4. Proper Cell Alignment

- 3. Ensure that the arrow position markers are aligned. See Figure 4.a
- Check that the flow indicators on the cell are in line with the flow indicators on the cell housing. See Figure 4.b and 4.c.
- Connect the power cable at the power pack assembly.
- Restore electrical power at breaker.
- Return pool system to normal operation.
