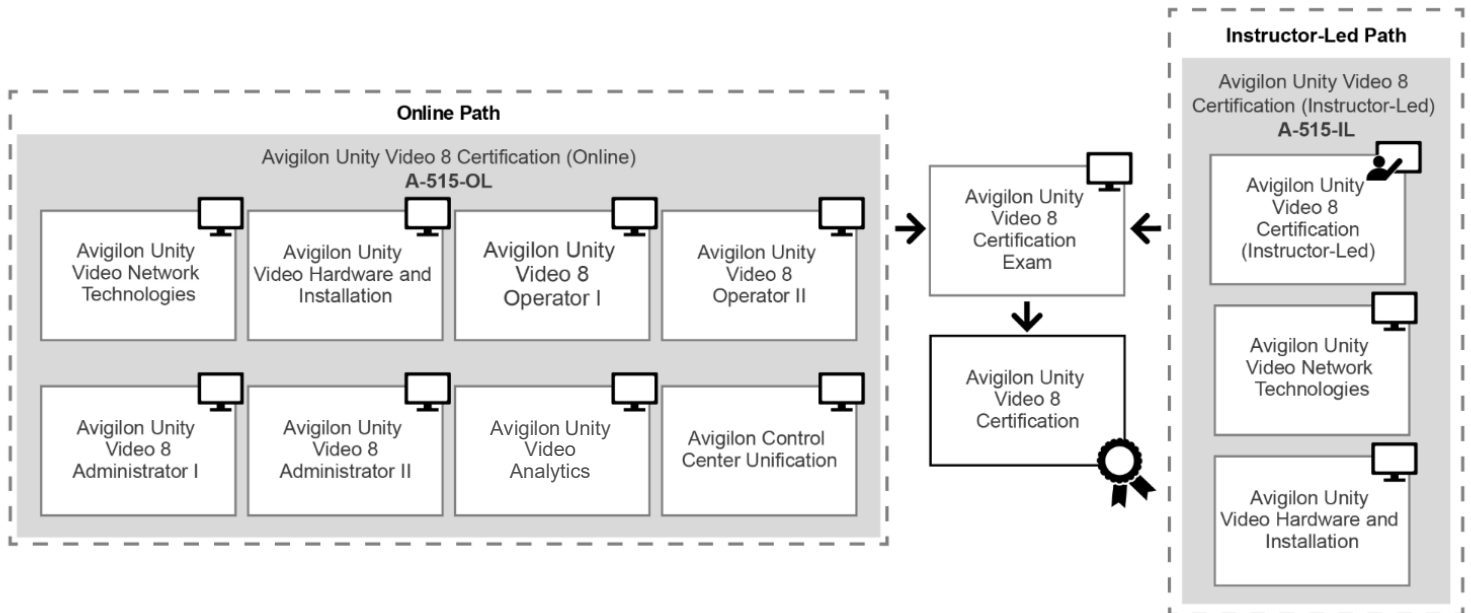

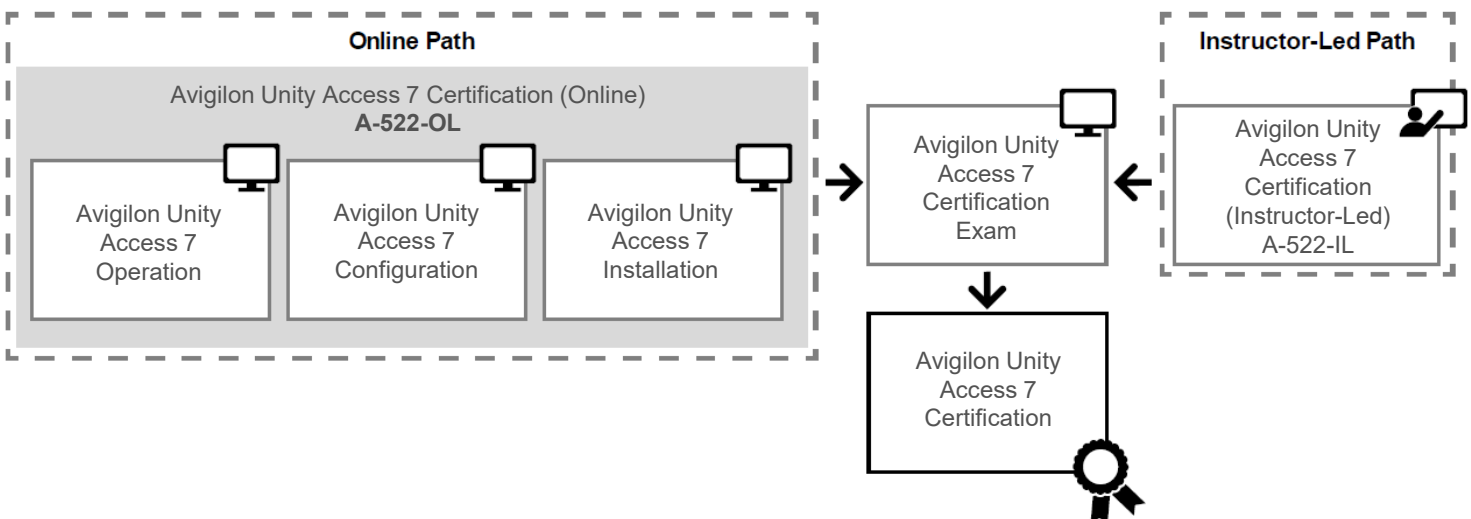

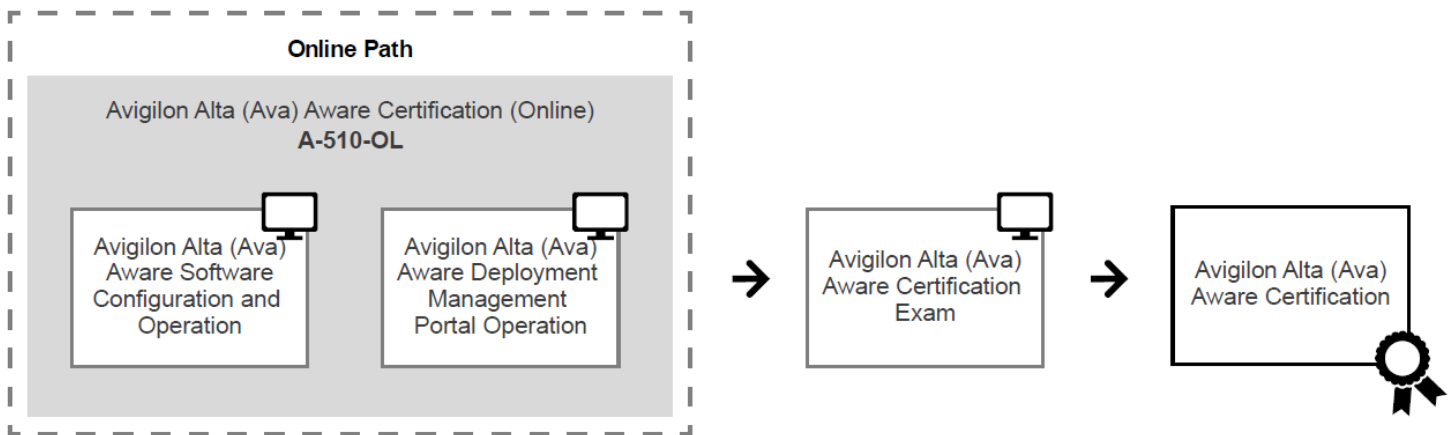
Avigilon Unity (ACC) Video Surveillance Online and Instructor-Led Certification Paths



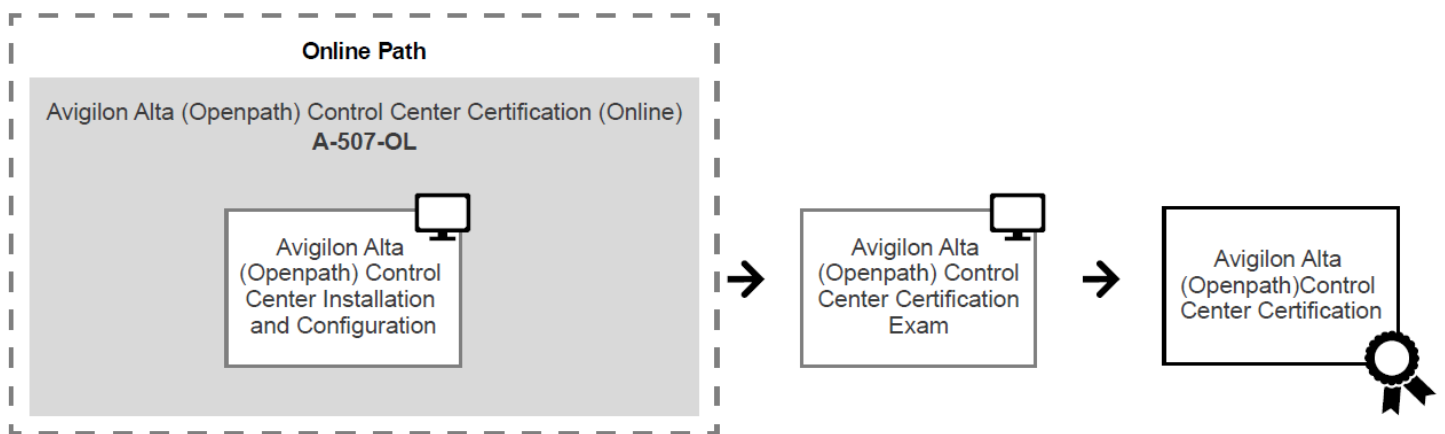
Avigilon Unity (ACM) Access Control Online and Instructor-Led Certification Paths



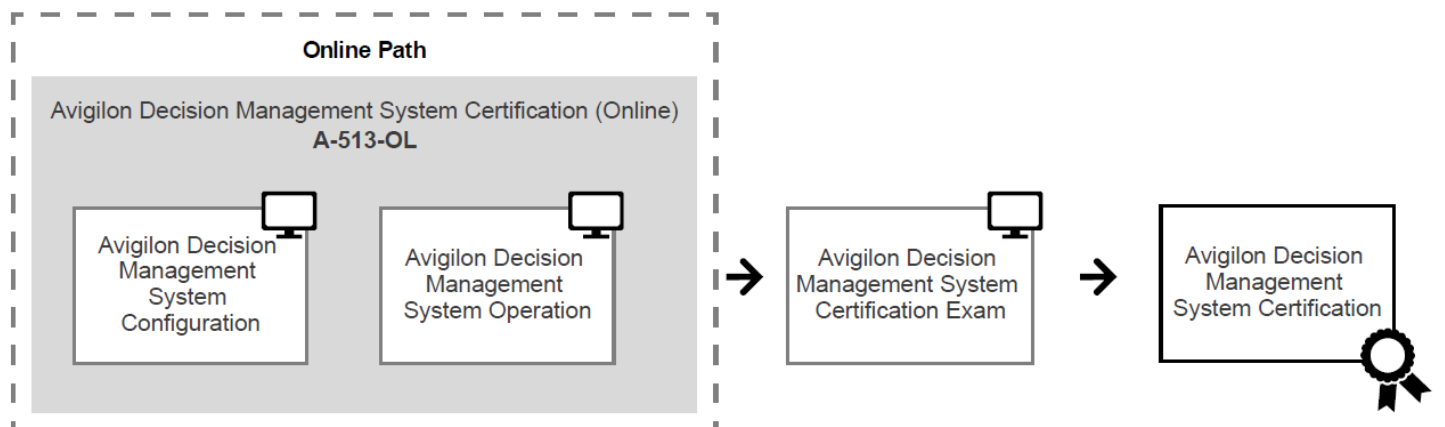
Avigilon Alta (Ava) Video Surveillance Online Certification Path

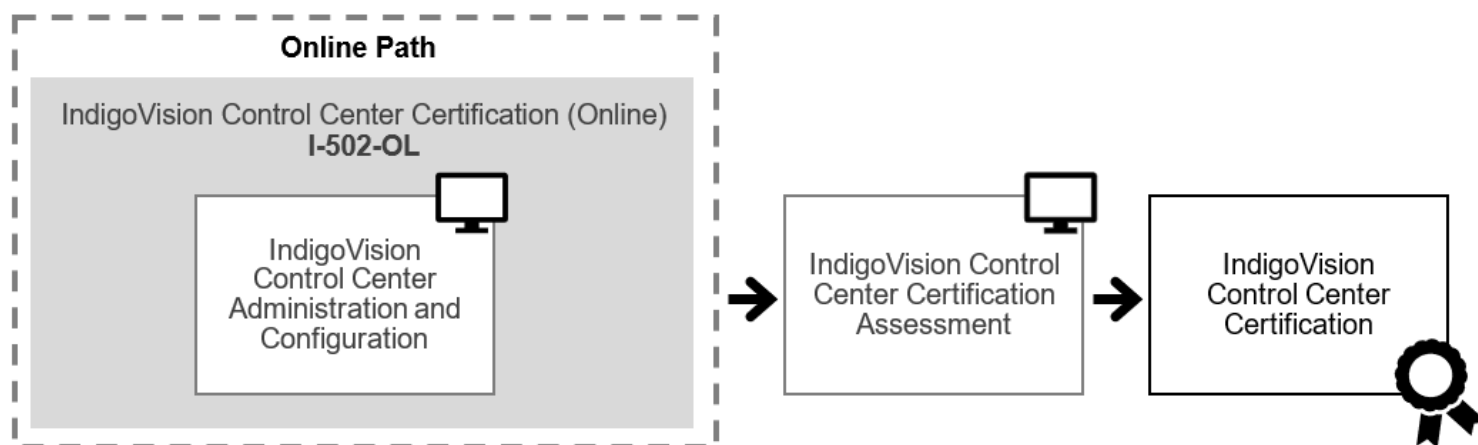

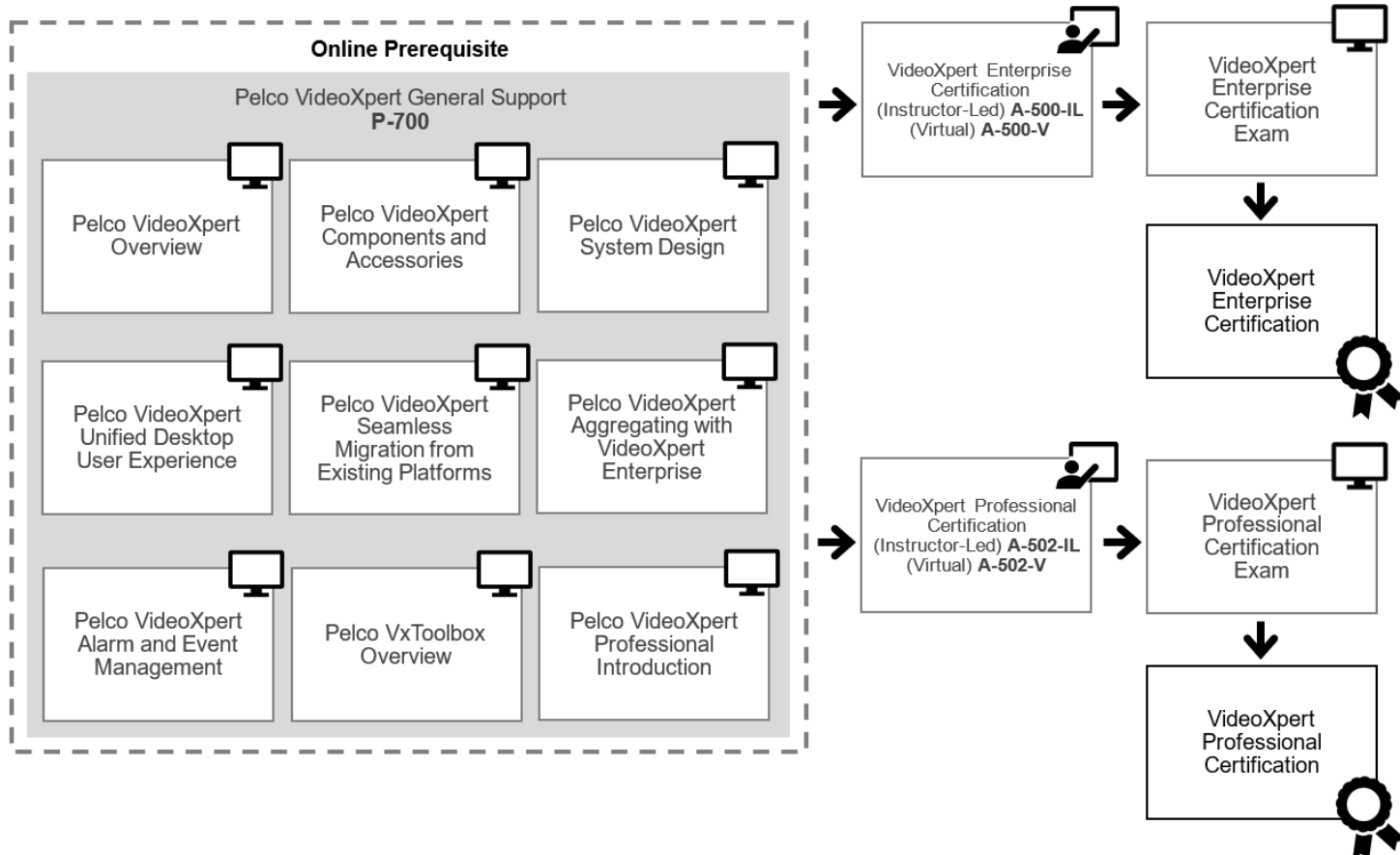
