

## 2001 OLDSMOBILE INTRIGUE

#### **IN-DASH APPLICATION:**

Dash Type: GM Double DIN

Kit: <u>GM1580/1583</u> Harness: <u>GM03</u>

Antenna Adapter: MDA1

#### **FRONT SPEAKERS:**

Front Door: 5 1/4" 4-Hole Speaker, and 1 1/4"Tweeter

#### **REAR SPEAKERS:**

Rear Deck: Standard 6x9" Speaker

When installing an aftermarket 5 ¼" or 6 ½" speakers, a speaker adapter is needed. We recommend the Scosche SA69 speaker adapter.

#### **WIRE COLOR CODES:**

+12V CONSTANT = ORANGE

+12V Accessory Switched = Yellow

-12V Chassis Ground = Black/White +12V Illumination = Brown/White

LF+ = Tan

LF- = Grey

RF+ = Lt. Green

RF- = Dk. Green

LR+ = Brown

LR- = Yellow

RR+ = Dk. Blue

RR- = Lt. Blue

# 2001 OLDSMOBILE INTRIGUE Sedan

**PRELIMINARY:** Disconnect the negative battery cable.

**ANTENNA:** The factory antenna is located in the rear window.

#### RADIO REMOVAL AND IN-DASH INSTALLATION:

Note: The factory stereo provision is for a Double DIN radio. For a DIN unit we recommend the Scosche kit GM1583/GM1580.

- 1. Carefully use a panel removal tool and pry dash bezel off.
- Extract (3) 9/32 screws securing radio, disconnect and remove.

# FRONT DOOR SPEAKER REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION: Note: The factory speaker provision is for a 5 ¼" speaker mounted to the factory speaker adapter. Also a 1 ¼" Tweeter.

- 1. Remove screw cover cap in interior door opener cup, and extract (1) Philips screw, remove bezel.
- 2. Extract (1) T27 Torx screw from behind door handle.
- 3. Extract (2) Philips screws from bottom of door panel.
- 4. Pry out window control panel and extract (1) T27 Torx screw from behind.
- Use panel removal tool and unsnap panel fastener all the way around panel, pull upwards, disconnect and remove door panel.
- 6. Extract (4) 9/32 screws securing speaker, disconnect and remove speaker.

### REAR DECK SPEAKER REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION:

Note: The factory speaker provision is for a 6 x 9" mounted to the rear deck. When installing an aftermarket 5 ¼ or 6 ½" speaker a speaker adapter is required. We recommend the use of a Scosche SA69 speaker adapter.

- 1. Remove bottom seat cushion by pulling seat releases on front bottom part of cushion.
- 2. Extract (2) 10 mm bolts holding rear seat back cushion and remove.
- 3. Pull away door molding and pry off top C pillar panel using panel removal tool and remove.
- 4. Carefully pull rear deck out then up, and remove.
- Extract (4) 9/32" screw from speaker, disconnect and remove.
