

# **Selfie Stick** Manual

#### 5. This product has two different remote control styles Remote Control please refer to the actual style shall prevail Indicator Power Button Shutters 1. Turn the switch to the on position, the indicator light will be on. 2. Open the Bluetooth settings on your cell phone and find the device name "Selfie" in the device list. Click on it to pair. 3. In the system camera, click the photo button to take photos or record videos. 4.Please turn off the power when you finish using it to minimize the power loss. Tips: This Bluetooth remote control is compatible with Android 4.3, IOS 5.0 and above.
