




Structure

- 1. 3 stage sharpening system
- 2. On/Off Button

- 4. A removable panel for collecting metal shaving
- 5. Adaptor






Stage 1 Crude

Begins the sharpening process with rough diamond grinding wheel to create the proper angle for blunt knives.



Stage 2 Fine

Continues sharpening with smooth diamond grinding wheel that gives the blade a precision edge.



Stage 3 Polish

Completes the process with ceramic grinding wheel that polishes the blade to an extra,razor-sharp edge.

Features

Instructions For Use

- 1. Put the sharpener in a stable position, clean the knife and dry it.
- 2. Power on the sharpener and turn on the switch on the left.
- 3. Put the knife into the sharpening groove to make the blade touches the rotating grinding wheel.
- 4. Pull back slowly (about 5 seconds) until the blade all pass through the grinding wheel.
- 5. As the knife tip comes into the grinder, slowly raise your hand and follow the contour of the blade to ensure all the edge comes in contact with the grinder.
- 6. Repeat 3-5 in the right-side slot to sharpen both sides of the blade.
- 7. After completing several paired passes, check the blade for a burr (raised metal) along the knife-edge with your fingers. If there is no burr, repeat paired passes until a burr is present. (Number of passes will depend on how dull the blade is.)
- 8. Repeat the process in the next stage to remove the burr.
- 9. If you are using a 3-stage unit, repeat process in the final stage.
- 10. For a very clean edge, finish with a couple of quick (1 or 2 seconds) paired passes through the fine grit slots.
- 11. Clean the blade with mild soap and water and wipe dry to remove any residual metal filings.

Tips

- 1. Each stage have left and right grinding grooves for sharpening both sides of blades.
- 2. Place the knife obliquely against the inclined side to get a better sharpening effect.





- 3. To create more stability, hold the knife sharpener with one hand during use, ensuring your hand is away from the blade and sharpening motion.
- 4. Open the removable collection panel at the bottom to clean metal dust.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- 1. Clean up debris after each use to avoid damage to the sharpener. Attention: Unplug the power plug before cleaning.
- 2. Unplug before cleaning.
- 3. Wipe the surface with a clean soft cloth.
- 4. DO NOT immerse the sharpener in water for cleaning.
- 5. Store the sharpener in a dry and ventilated place.

Precautions:

- 2. DO NOT add water, oil or other substances when sharpening knives to avoid danger.
- 3. The sharpener is not suitable for grinding curved, zigzag tools.
- 4. DO NOT allow water to flow into the sharpener to avoid damage.
- 5. In case the grinding wheel is stopped by knives, remove knives immediately to avoid damage to the sharpener.
- 6. Do not pull the plug out by the cord as this may damage the plug and/or the cable.
- 7. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 8. Children should not play with the appliance.
- Do not run fingers along edge of knife to check sharpness. To avoid injury, handle knives with extreme care.
