Keys operations

	1.Long press (5 seconds), switch on/off 2.Press twice in a row to switch TF/Bluetooth mode
	1.Short press, music pause/play 2.Press twice in a row to redial the nearest phone number 3.Long press (1.5 seconds) to turn on the voice assistant 4.Short press to answer/hang up 5.Long press (2 seconds) to refuse to answer the phone.
	1.Short press to increase the volume 2.Long press (2 seconds) to play the next song
	1.Short press to reduce the volume 2.Long press (2 seconds) to play the previous song
