- Three-digit tape counter for measuring the tape contents

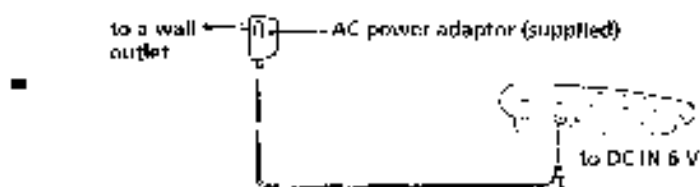


► Getting Started

Preparing a Power Source

Choose either of the following power sources.

House Current



Connect the AC power adaptor to DC IN 5V and to the wall outlet. Use only the supplied AC power adaptor. Do not use any other AC power adaptor.

Polarity of the plug

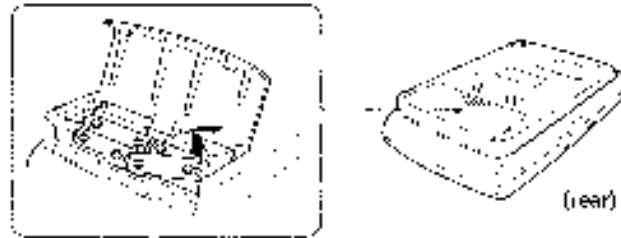


Note

Unplug the AC power adaptor from the wall outlet when it is not going to be used for an extended period of time. To disconnect the AC power adaptor, pull it out by grasping the AC power adaptor shell. Never pull it by the cord.

Dry Batteries

Make sure that nothing is connected to the DC IN 6V jack



- 1 Open the battery compartment lid.
- 2 Insert four size AA (R6) batteries (not supplied) with correct polarity and close the lid.

To take out the batteries

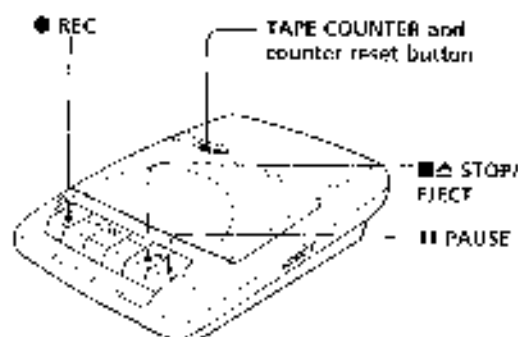

Notes

- Do not charge a dry battery.
- Do not use a new battery with an old one.
- Do not use different types of batteries.
- When you do not use the unit for a long time, remove the batteries to avoid any damage caused by battery leakage and subsequent corrosion.
- Dry batteries will not be expended when another power source is connected.

Recording

You can record right away with the built-in microphone. Make sure that nothing is connected to the MIC jack.



- 1 Press the counter reset button to reset the TAPE COUNTER.
- 2 Press ■▲ STOP/EJECT to open the cassette holder.
- 3 Insert a TYPE I (normal) tape with the side to start recording facing forward, and close the cassette holder.
- 4 Press ● REC.
► PLAY is depressed automatically.

At the end of the tape, recording stops and the unit turns off automatically.

To	Press
Stop recording	■▲ STOP/EJECT
Pause recording	PAUSE
	Press the Eject button again to resume recording.

Notes

- You can also monitor the recording sound.
- For recording, we recommend the use of TYPE I (normal) tapes only. Do not use TYPE II (CrO₂) and TYPE IV (metal) tapes.

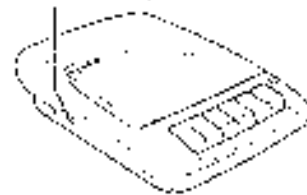
To prevent a tape from being accidentally recorded over

Break out and remove the cassette tabs. To reuse the tape for recording, cover the tab hole with adhesive tape.



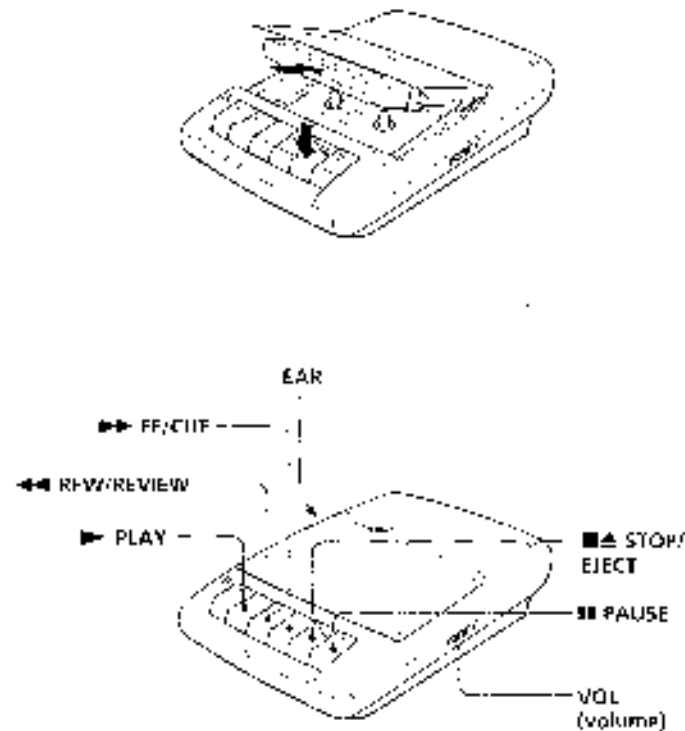
Recording with an External Microphone

MIC (PLUG IN POWER)



Connect a microphone of low impedance (not supplied) to the MIC jack. The built-in microphone is automatically disconnected. When using a plug-in-power system microphone, the power to the microphone is supplied from this unit.

Playing a Tape



- 1 Press **■▲ STOP/EJECT** to open the cassette holder.
- 2 Insert a TYPE I (normal) tape with the side to start play facing upward, and close the cassette holder.
- 3 Press **▶▶ PLAY** then adjust the volume.

At the end of the tape, playback stops and the unit turns off automatically.

To	Press or slide
Stop playback/stop fast forward or rewind	■▲ STOP/EJECT
Pause playback	 PAUSE Press the button again to resume play
Search forward during playback (F.F.)	Press and hold ▶▶ FF/CUE and release it at the point you want
Search backward during playback (R.V.)	Press and hold ◀◀ R-V/R-REVIEW and release it at the point you want
Fast forward	▶▶ FF/CUE during stop
Rewind	◀◀ R-V/R-REVIEW during stop

At the end of the tape

All the locked buttons will be automatically released (full auto shut-off mechanism).

To listen with an earphone

Connect an earphone (not supplied) to the EAR jack of the unit. The built-in speaker will be automatically disconnected.

Troubleshooting

Should any problem persist after you have made these checks, consult your nearest Sony dealer.

You cannot insert a cassette.

- The cassette is inserted incorrectly.
- ► PLAY is pressed.

You cannot press ● REC.

- No cassette in the cassette holder.
- The Lip on the tape has been removed.

You cannot press ► PLAY.

- The tape has reached the end. Rewind the tape.

The unit does not operate.

- No batteries in the battery compartment.
- The batteries have been inserted with incorrect polarity.
- The batteries are weak.
- The AC power adaptor is not firmly connected.
- The batteries have been inserted, but simultaneously the AC power adaptor is connected and not to be connected to the wall outlet.

- II (AC/DC) is pressed.

No sound comes from the speaker.

- The earphone is plugged in.
- The volume is turned down completely.

The sound drops out or comes with excessive noise.

- The batteries are weak.
- The heads are contaminated: See "Maintenance."

Recording cannot be made.

- Connection is made incorrectly.
- The batteries are weak.
- The record/playback head is contaminated.

Recording cannot be erased completely.

- The erase head is contaminated.
- TYPE II (CrO₂) or TYPE IV (metal) tape is used.

► Additional Information

Precautions

On power

- Operate the unit only on **AC/DC**.
For AC operation, use the AC power adaptor recommended for the unit. Do not use any other type. For battery operation, use four size AA (R6) batteries.
- The nameplate indicating operating voltage, etc., is located on the bottom of the unit.

On the unit

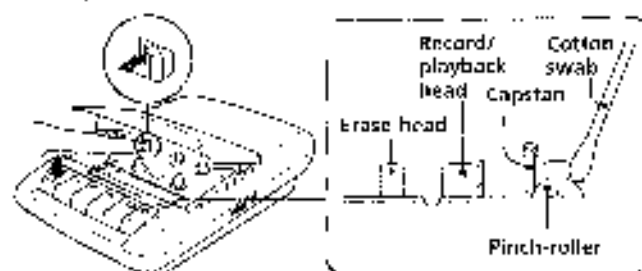
- Do not leave the unit in a location near heat sources or in a place subject to direct sunlight, excessive dust or mechanical shock.
- Should any solid object or liquid fall into the unit, remove the batteries or disconnect the AC power adaptor, and have the unit checked by qualified personnel before operating it any further.
- Keep personal credit cards using magnetic coding or spring wound watches etc. away from the unit to prevent possible damage from the magnet near the speaker.
- If the unit has not been used for a long time, set it in the playback mode and warm it up for a few minutes before inserting a tape.

On tapes longer than 90 minutes

We do not recommend the use of tapes longer than 90 minutes except for a long continuous recording or playback. They are very thin and tend to be stretched easily.

Maintenance



To clean the tape heads and path

Wipe the heads, pinch rollers, and the capstan with a cotton swab moistened with alcohol every 10 hours of use.

Before cleaning, press **REC** while pushing the lever as shown in the illustration. After cleaning, press **▲** **STOP** **▶/EJECT**.

To clean the exterior

Use a soft cloth slightly moistened in water. Do not use alcohol, benzene or thinner.
