Note:

- To provide a stable power supply, kindly use the cable provided with the product and connect to AC 100-240V, 50/60 Hz powersource.
- Avoid the self-disassembly of the product as it results in the failure of Warranty.
- Avoid looking directly at the projector lens while it is active.
- Make sure that the projector's air vents are not blocked while in use. The device must be kept in a well ventilated surrounding for proper functioning.
- It is recommended to power OFF the projector after a continuous usage of 6 hours.
- Place the projector away from water or other liquids. Avoid water accumulation and ensure good ventilation.





AV: Connect the 3.5mm AV in.


AUX: Connect the 3.5mm audio device for audio output

USB: Open and access files from the connected USB device in the file manager and media center.



Setting up the Projector


- 1 Plug the power cord into the projector's AC power input. Insert the other end of the power cord into a standard wall power socket. Ensure the wall socket is turned on to supply power.
- 2 Please place the projector on a flat surface to ensure projection. Now turn the projector on by pressing the power button either on the panel or on the remote.
- 3 The projector should be aligned straight to the screen/the place of projection.



Projection Distance & Size

The recommended projector screen size is 101 - 381 cm. For an improved viewing experience, it is recommended to use the

projector in a room that provided as much darkness as possible.



Keystone Adjustment

- Select "Settings" and go to "Keystone Correction."
- To make a manual adjustment, turn off the "Auto" option.
- · Once the "Auto" option is off, you can adjust the keystone correction manually.
- · To enable automatic keystone correction, turn on the "Auto" option.

Auto Keystone



Manual keystone

Select and enter Quadrangular trapezoid, use the "OK" key of the remote control to switch the points to be adjusted, and then use the "direction key" to adjust different points. The "menu" key can reset the display effect, and the "return" key can return to the upper screen and save the adjustment effect.



Projection Mode:

Select and enter "Projection Mode", there are four options: "Rotate Front", "Rotate Ceiling", "Rotate Rear" and "Rotate Rear Ceiling".



Android Home

- 1. Once the Projector is turned on, the projector will lead you to the home screen.
- The Home Screen displays apps, settings, menu, Network, source, file browser.




Settings

Switch to home page, open the settings main menu. This menu contains sub menu like...


USB Interface

Plug the USB to the port present at the rear side of the projector. Now navigate to the USB tab present in the home page.



HDMI Interface

Once the HDMI is connected to the projector, you will need to select the specific signal source as input. After connecting, the content played on the source will be streamed on the projector.



Bluetooth Settings

- 1. Go to Settings > Bluetooth Settings.
- 2. Turn the Bluetooth connection on and search for nearby bluetooth devices.
- 3. Choose the desired bluetooth device to pair and connect.

File Manager

You can view external storage devices such as USB drives in the file manager.



Network Settings

Enter **Settings > Networking setting**, in the Wi-Fi settings interface, connect to a network using one of the following methods:

- Select the target Wi-Fi network from the available network list. If the network is encrypted, you'll need to enter the password.
- Pull down the page, select "Add new network", and follow the on-screen prompts to enter the network name and access password to complete the Wi-Fi connection.
