- Only use the PUQ Prep Navigator as described in this document.

# **3 PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

#### 3.1 Intended use

The PUQ Prep Navigator is intended as an automatic coffee distributor for the ground coffee in a portafilter.

Grounded coffee can be distributed with adjustable settings.

The PUQ Prep Navigator is only intended to be used on portafilters (group handles) with a larger diameter than 57.3 mm / 2.6 inch. The PUQ Prep Navigator is intended to be used for commercial applications, for example in kitchens of restaurants, canteens, hospitals and in commercial enterprises such as bakeries, butcheries, etc., but not for continuous mass production of food.

The PUQ Prep Navigator is intended for indoor use only.

Any modification of the PUQ Prep Navigator may have consequences for safety, warranty and proper functioning.

#### 3.3 Main parts

See 1 for an overview of the main parts of the Navigator.

- 1. USB-C port
- 2. Left touch button
- 3. DOT LED display
- 4. Right touch button
- 5. Main push button



- 6. Notch for removing needle ring
- 7. White or black needle ring (19 grams / 0.67 ounce or more)
- 8. Anthracite needle ring (19 grams / 0.67 ounce or less)
- 9. USB-A to USB-C cable
- 10. USB charger

#### **4 INSTALLATION**

#### 4.1 Preparation

#### 4.1.1 Checking the contents

Check that all parts are present and that no damage is visible on the parts. If parts are missing or damaged, contact your dealer or your authorised customer service centre.

#### 4.1.2 Tools and materials

#### 4.2 Charging the PUQ Prep Navigator

Charge the PUQ Prep Navigator before first use and when the battery is down to 25 percent. The display shows LOW if the battery is almost empty.

- Plug the USB-A to USB-C cable into the USB-C port.
- Plug the other end of the USB-A to USB-C cable into the supplied adapter.
- Plug the USB adapter into a socket and/ or (wall) outlet.

The display shows the battery level.

# NOTICE

- The battery of the PUQ Prep Navigator is charged to a maximum of 30 percent when delivered.
- The battery of the PUQ Prep Navigator can be charged up to 99 percent.
- The PUQ Prep Navigator cannot be used during charging.

#### 4.3 Changing the needle ring

 Check if the portafilter (group handle) can hold more or less than 19 grams / 0.67 ounce of coffee.

If the portafilter can hold 19 grams / 0.67 ounce or more of coffee, the installed needle ring is correct for your portafilter.

If the portafilter can hold less than 19 grams / 0.67 ounce of coffee, follow the next steps.

- Remove the white or black needle ring with your thumbs or a flat head screwdriver.
- Insert and fasten the anthracite needle ring. 3

#### 4.4 Switching on the PUQ Prep Navigator

 Press and hold the main push button for 1 second to switch on the PUQ Prep Navigator.

#### **5 OPERATION**

#### 5.1 Preparation

#### 5.1.1 Tools and materials

#### Required tools and materials

Portafilter (group handle) with grounded coffee

#### 5.2 Adjusting the distribution profile

 Press and hold the left touch button or right touch button for 1 second.

The PUQ Prep Navigator vibrates and the distribution profile blinks on the display.

- Press the left touch button or right touch button to scroll through the distribution profiles.
- 3. Choose between the following distribution profiles:

Code	Setting	Explanation
SPD	SPEEDY	Fast distributing speed 1.5 seconds
STD	STANDARD	Default distributing speed 3 seconds
PRE	PRECISE	Slow distributing speed 5 seconds

- 4. Press the **main push button** to confirm the setting.
- Press the left touch button or right touch button to set a delay time interval.

The delay time interval can be set between 0 and 10 seconds with an interval of 0.5 seconds.

6. Press the **main push button** to confirm the delay time interval.

The display shows the selected distribution profile.

#### 5.3 Using the PUQ Prep Navigator

- 1. Place the PUQ Prep Navigator on the portafilter (group handle). 4
- Press the main push button to start distributing the ground coffee.

# NOTICE

- The PUQ Prep Navigator switches to sleep mode automatically after 30 seconds.
- The PUQ Prep Navigator switches off



- automatically after 5 minutes.
- Shake the product or press the main push button to wake up the PUO Prep Navigator.

#### 5.4 Adjusting other settings

 Press and hold the left touch button or right touch button for 1 second.

The PUQ Prep Navigator vibrates and the distribution profile blinks on the display.

- Press and hold the main push button for 3 seconds. The DOT LED display shows DIS.
- Press the left touch button or right touch button to scroll through the other settings.
- 4. Choose between the following settings:

Code	Setting	Explanation
DIS	Display intensity	Press the left touch button and the right touch button to change the display intensity. Default is 75 percent.
BUR	Burn-in/run-in test	Test the motor of the PUQ Prep Navigator.
FAC	Factory test	Perform an initial factory test.

VER	Version number	Check the version number of the PUQ Prep Navigator.
CNT	Cycle counter	Check the amount of user cycles. Multiply the number on the display by 500.
EXI	Exit	Exit the other settings. Exiting via EXI saves the changed DIS settings.

Press the main push button to confirm/ enter the setting.

The display intensity can be set between 25 and 100 percent with steps of 25 percent.

 Press the main push button to confirm exiting the menu when the display shows EXI. The changed DIS settings are saved.

# NOTICE

The PUQ Prep Navigator exits the other settings automatically after 10 seconds of inactivity or movements. Changed settings are not saved.

# 5.5 Switching off the PUQ Prep Navigator

 Press and hold the main push button for 3 seconds to switch off the PUQ Prep Navigator.

### **6 MAINTENANCE**

#### 6.1 Preparation

#### 6.1.1 Tools and materials

#### Required tools and materials

- Brush
- · Dry cloth

#### 6.2 Cleaning

- Remove the needle ring with your thumbs or a flat head screwdriver.
- 2. Clean the needle ring.
- 3. Reinsert the needle ring.

Refer to the table for an overview of the cleaning intervals.

Part		Cleaning method	Cleaning interval
Needle	ring	Brush	Weekly
Housing	]	Dry cloth	Monthly

# NOTICE

Make sure to clean the parts of the PUQ Prep following the cleaning intervals. Not doing so may result in parts of the PUQ Prep Navigator getting damaged.

#### 6.3 Storing

Store the PUQ Prep Navigator indoors in a dry and secure location, out of reach of children

#### 6.4 Maintaining

#### 6.4.1 Servicing

Any required repairs may only be conducted by authorized specialist personnel. For this reason, please contact a customer service repair facility or your dealer. Refer to the safety instructions in chapter 'Safety instructions'.

It is advised to conduct all maintenance and repairs by a customer service centre or your distributor.

#### 6.4.2 Ordering spare parts

Spare parts can be ordered from your customer service centre or your local distributor.

To ensure quick and correct processing of your order, the following information is essential:

- Serial number
- Description of the part to be replaced.
   Use the same name as the part is specified as in chapter 'Main parts'.



# 7 TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Cause(s)	Solution(s)
The PUQ Prep Navigator does not switch on, the display does not work.	The battery of the PUQ Prep Navigator is empty.	Charge the PUQ Prep Navigator.
The display shows three dots and switches off.	The battery of the PUQ Prep Navigator is empty.	Charge the PUQ Prep Navigator.
The display shows LOW.	The battery of the PUQ Prep Navigator is empty.	Charge the PUQ Prep Navigator.
The drive unit makes weird noises.	The drive unit (e-motor and gears) is worn out.	Contact the distributor to replace the drive unit. Specify the amount of battery charging cycles the drive unit has had.
Ground coffee is not distributed properly.	The wrong needle ring is used.	Change the needle ring to the correct size.

In case of other malfunctions or continued faults, please contact your dealer or your authorised customer service centre.
