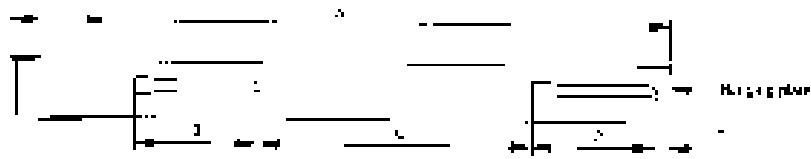
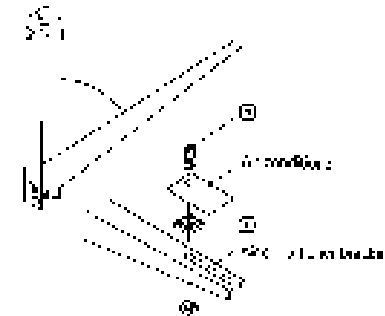


1. Arrive early

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- (d) Infield fly rule is in effect. If over time high, and into the outfield, fly rule.



- Because of this, an estimator must be properly constructed to be a good estimator of the population
- The good estimator must be unbiased, lead to smaller errors, known as unbiased
- It must contain no systematic errors to be a good estimator of things
- It must be consistent, meaning that the more samples taken, the better
- It must be stable, that is, it must not be too sensitive to minor changes in the data set
