General Guidelines for Long-Term Performance

1. Introduction

This manual provides essential care instructions for outdoor furniture, including plastic, metal, and fabric products. Following these guidelines ensures durability and maintains appearance through seasonal changes.

2. Daily Cleaning & Maintenance

For All Products:

Cleaning Frequency: Rinse monthly with water; deep clean seasonally.

Method:

Use mild soap (e.g., dish detergent) and lukewarm water.

Scrub gently with a soft brush or cloth.

Rinse thoroughly and air-dry.

Avoid:

Harsh chemicals (bleach, acids), abrasive tools, or high-pressure washers.

3. Storage Guidelines

Short-Term (Off-Season):

Clean and dry thoroughly.

Stack with protective padding (e.g., foam) between items.

Long-Term:

Disassemble removable parts (e.g., umbrella fabric).

Store in dry, ventilated areas; avoid plastic wraps (traps moisture).

4. Safety & Best Practices

Heat Warning: Metal/plastic surfaces may become hot in direct sun.

Weight Limits: Adhere to manufacturers load capacity (e.g., swing chair: ≤600 lb).

Stability: Anchor freestanding items (e.g., umbrellas) in windy areas.



Safety Warnings

Critical for Swings & Suspended Products:

Limits:

Do not stand or kneel on swings.

Installation:

Hang only from structural beams rated for dynamic loads (e.g., 4×4 " cedar or reinforced metal).

Verify clearance: ≥6 ft (2 m) from obstacles in all swing directions.

Usage:

Children must be supervised.

Check ropes/chains monthly for fraying, rust, or weakness.

Never swing empty seats violently (causes undue stress on anchors).



General Safety:

Do not climb on roofs or non-load-bearing structures.

Locate underground utilities before installing stakes/anchors.

Maintain \geq 6 ft (2 m) clearance from overhead power lines.

Grills/fire pits must be \geq 10 ft (3 m) away from any structure.
