

BASIC CROCHET STITCH DIAGRAM

1. Stitch (Abbreviated 'st')

Every piece of crochet chain starts with a slip knot. Loop the yarn over the hook, leaving a tail. Pull the tail through the loop, then the hook into the loop and pull the tail through the loop.



2. Chain Stitch (Abbreviated 'ch')

The chain stitch is the basis for all crochet which is also called a foundation chain.



3. Slip Stitch (Abbreviated 'sl st')

The slip stitch is the fastest and easiest of all crochet stitches. You can use this stitch to pick up the ends of a foundation chain to form a rib.



4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')

The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches. Grab the yarn with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull it through both loops, leaving one loop on the hook.



5. Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')

You can increase the size by making 2 stitches at the beginning of the row. For example, make 2 stitches in the same way.



6. Front loop only (Abbreviated 'floo')

Work with the single front stitch closest to your body.



7. Magic Ring

A magic ring is an adjustable starting round used for crocheting amigurumi, cushions, garment sleeves and other projects that work in circular rounds. Wrap a loop with your yarn. You will need to keep the yarn around your fingers, insert the hook through the loop. Slide the crocheted loop under right index of your left hand to the left, use the hook to pull yarn into a left loop, pull the yarn through the ring, make a single stitch, pull tight.

First row of stitches also working. For example, make a sc, 14 sc, 14 sc, 14 sc. Hold the starting end at the yarn tail while gently pulling down on the tail end. As you do this, the stitches should close together at the center, completing your magic ring. Finally, do work into the first stitch. To start the second row, insert the remainder of your pattern, make a slip stitch into the first stitch of your ring, and proceed to the next round.



8. Fasten Off (Abbreviated 'F/O')

Fasten off by pulling the yarn through the last stitch and pulling it tight.



9. Round (Abbreviated 'rd')

This sign tells the reader that you are in a circle. Each round starts with a slip stitch into the first stitch.

10. Sewing

Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The thread needs to be sewn into the fabric through the hole, where the two parts need to be connected.



It is used to be attached into the fabric, such as a seam, a button, a eye, etc. Use the photo below and thread to create small stitches to represent body features etc.



11. Weaving In/Invisible Close

Use the yarn, leaving a long yarn end. Close the end through the first loop on the hook and thread it into a yarn needle. Weave your needle through the first loop only, on the first round and pull tight. Repeat remaining yarn into your piece.



Please ensure that all yarn ends to be hidden behind the fabric.
