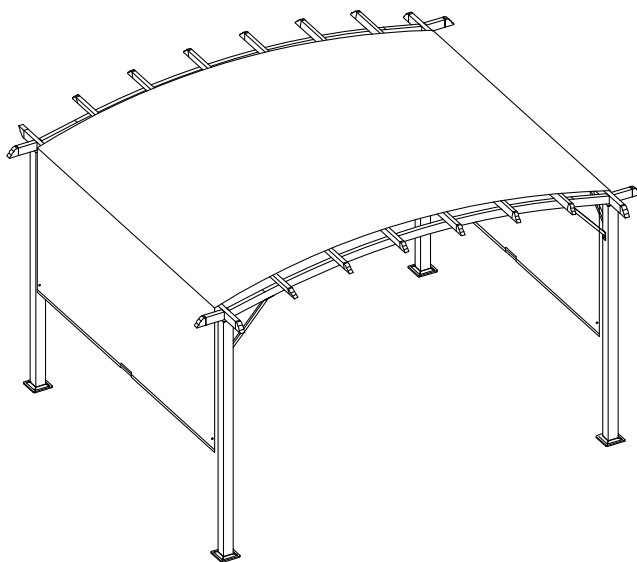


Pergola Gazebo Canopy SS16033BG

Assembly Instructions



Before You Start

- ⊙ The pergola will be shipped in 2 parcels.(contact us if any issue)
- ⊙ Retain instructions for future reference.
- ⊙ Separate and count all parts and hardware.
- ⊙ Read through each step carefully and follow the proper order.
- ⊙ We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
- ⊙ Always place the product on a flat, steady and stable surface.
- ⊙ Keep all small parts and packaging materials for this product away from babies and children as they potentially pose a serious choking hazard.

Note: This gazebo is meant to be used for decorative and sunshade purpose only, not meant to withstand any elements of the weather.

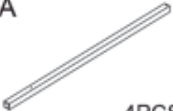
Please untie the ropes and remove the canopy before bad weather conditions.

- 3). Please keep the parts list, it could be useful to reorder some parts for service if necessary.

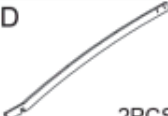
