Assembly Precautions

- **Read the Manual First**: Before starting the assembly of your garden shed, it is crucial to read the assemble manual in advance. Size Tolerance: The dimensions of the garden shed are obtained through manual measurement. As a result, there may be some reasonable error. The overall size is specified as 36.6x21.9x63 inches (length x width x height), and each shelf has a weight capacity of 33 lbs. However, minor deviations in size are to be expected. This does not mean there is a defect in the product, and it should not cause any significant issues during use.

Care and Maintenance

- Weather resistant Features: The garden shed is designed to be weather resistant. The asphalt waterproof roof protects against rain, snow, and sunlight. Regularly check the roof for any signs of damage, such as cracks or holes. If you notice any issues, contact customer service for guidance on repair. The polycarbonate panels are durable and provide good insulation. Keep them clean by gently wiping them with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could scratch the panels.
- **Storage and Organization**: The shed comes with four adjustable shelves, two of which are foldable. Use these shelves to organize your gardening tools, plants, or other items. When storing items, make sure not to exceed the weight capacity of each shelf. The adjustable foot pads help the shed adapt to uneven ground.
