How to connect to the product?

Open the Apple Find My app and make sure Bluetooth is turned on.

Other Supported Item

Make Sure the device is in a power on state, then add other item.

How to power on?

press the button once, the device is power on.

How to power off?

press and hold the button for 5 seconds, the device is power off.

How to reset?

press the button 4 times within 2 seconds, then press and hold the button until you hear the beeps, the device is in reset state.

Main functions of products

1. "Find My" the network location

When the device exceeds the Bluetooth distance from the phone, the device cannot Bluetooth in the search list.
Select: Lost Mode - Enabled. Enter your contact phone number, etc. If the device has been disconnected from your phone for more than a while, and there is another Apple device near the device, you will receive notifications and the latest location of the smart tag.
2.Play the sound
Mobile phone and device in the Bluetooth model domestic (generally about 20 meters) in the "Find My" App, click, play the sound. The device will issue a prompt sound, help you quickly find the near by smart tag.
3.How to protect my privacy?
Where your devices, only you can see it for yourself! Your location data and history will never be stored in the smart tag. The device that delivers your smart tag location data also remain anonymous, and location data is encrypted at every step of the search. So, Apple doesn't know where your device is or who belongs to help find it.
4.How to replace the battery for the equipment?
You need to use the wiring in the product accessories to gently pry the upper cover to remove the battery. Battery life is usually one year.
5.What is a "Find My" network? How to work?
Apple Find My Network provides an easy, secure way to find compatible personal items on maps using iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, "Find My" App on Mac, or Find Items apps on Apple Watch. Simply your compatible product with Apple's "Find My" App, i.e., so view it with your pair Apple device if you item is lost, you can set it to Lost mode, allowing it to display messages and contact information to anyone who finds it. Find My's network is encrypted and anonymous, so no one else, including Apple, can view its location.
Frequently asked questions
1.When can the device be targeted by other Apple devices?
When the device is separated from the owner, Find My Network uses Bluetooth sensors on hundreds of millions of Apple products to report the location of a lost Apple device nearby. When the Apple device on the network detects a lost smart tag device nearby, it reports the approximate location of the lost item to the owner of the device via the internet.
2.How to prevent devices from being used for malicious tracking?
When someone else's device incorporates your belongings and tracks them for more than a while, you are reminded in two ways:
If you have iPhone, iPad, etc., Apple devices, you will be alerted on the Apple device to iOS 14 or iPadOS 14, and later versions of Apple devices.
If you don't have an Apple device and if someone else's smart tag leaves its own owner, Well tracks you for awhile, and when it moves, it emits a cue tone to alert you. Of course, we're not need to worry if your friends happen to be carrying the equipment, or if many people on the sub way you take have it. Because as long as the device does not leave the owner, such reminders are not triggered.
Important tips
When the device is paired with the search App, it needs to connect to the Apple server. If it cannot be paired, the network you cannot be connected to the Apple server temporarily. The following operations are recommended:
Replace the mobile network, such as switching between WiFi and cellular network.
Return to the factory settings for the equipment.
Required with the backup App.
Regulatory security information
