Nunchuk Usage Instructions:



Connection:

The Nunchuk connects to the bottom extension port of the Wii Remote. Ensure the correct orientation of the Nunchuk plug, then insert it into the bottom port of the Wii Remote. Once connected, the Nunchuk and Wii Remote function as a single unit for game control.

Operation Button:

The Nunchuk features a handle-shaped operation button, often referred to as the "C" button. This button may have different functions in various games, typically used for executing actions such as jumping, attacking, etc.
