



1.Connect power adaptor to power adaptor jack. 2. Rotating the power knob (12) clockwise to turn on the unit, the power indicator will light on.



How to Play Bluetooth:

1. When turn on the record player, it will show flashing blue light, means the turntable is searching and waiting to connect to Bluetooth

3. When the Bluetooth device has connected successfully, the blue light will no longer

- 2. Switch the Bluetooth function of your Bluetooth output device on (such as a mobile phone)and select the Bluetooth equipment code"UD001"to connect
- flash but be static 4.Start playback of the music on your Bluetooth device and enjoy the music through the
- speakers of this turntable

Notes:

1.When play vinyl record you cannot use the Bluetooth function, you need to stop playing vinyl record and putting the arm down, when the indicator show blue light flashing, you can connect with your phone or other Bluetooth devices.

- 2.If you want to connect the unit to another Bluetooth enabled device after you've already successfully paired, turn off the Bluetooth on the device that was previously paired with the unit. The light will be flashing blue again, repeat step 1-4 above.
- 3.This record player only support Bluetooth input, not support Bluetooth output. If you want to connect an external speaker, please connect it via RCA jack.

How to Play LP: LP Vinyl Record Play Mode

- Remove the stylus protector.

1. Place the record on the turntable, use the 45 rpm adaptor if required. 2.Set the speed selector to the correct position, depending on the record to be played.

3. Push the lift lever up to raise the tone arm from the arm rest, and then slowly move it to the

record side. The turntable will start to rotate. (Turn off the automatic stop switch, the turntable will keep on rotating) 4. Put down the lift lever to drop the tone arm and touch the record gently.

Record player playing starts now.


5. Push the lift lever upward to raise the tone arm from the arm rest, the turntable will still be rotating but record player playing will stop. To continue the playing, the lift lever needs to be put down. 6. Adjust the volume to the desired level.

7. At the end of a record, push the lift lever upward to raise the tone arm and move it to the arm rest, and then put down the lift lever. 8. Turn off the turntable or stop manually (Lift the tone arm from the record

How to Use Auto Stop Switch?

1. When you choose "turn on" the AUTO STOP switch, the turntable will stop spinning automatically 2.When you choose "turn off" the AUTO STOP switch, the turntable will keep spinning 3.If your vinyl has a few songs, we advise you turn on it, after music finishing, it will stop spinning 4.If your vinyl has many songs, we advise you turn off it, it may stop playback in the middle if you turn on it

5.Note:Sometimes, when your record has been scratched or damaged, it may still keep spinning or repeat skipping even if you turn on the AUTO STOP switch, in this case, we advise you change the vinyls or position the torn arm to its original place to stop it .



How to Use Aux Input:

Audio JACK/ Aux In play mode: Put the tone arm back to arm rest, then connect the external audio device (such as CD player) through the AUX IN jack (13) on the back panel. Audio signal from the external audio device can be played through the system. The player will switch into Aux In play mode automatically once insert the audio cable into the Aux In jack (13).

How to Connect External Speaker RCA output jack is at the back of the turntable

1.For Active Speaker:Connect the RCA audio cable to the RCA Output Jack at the back of the turntable, then plug the other end into your active speaker, the sound will be transferred from turntable to your external active speaker

2.For Passive Speaker:Connect the RCA audio cable to the RCA Output Jack at the back of the turntable, then plug the other end into an amplifier,next,connect the amplifier with your passive speaker, the sound will finally be transferred from turntable to your passive speaker

Warning

Do not manually lower the tone arm onto the LP disk, to avoid LP disk and stylus(9) damage!






