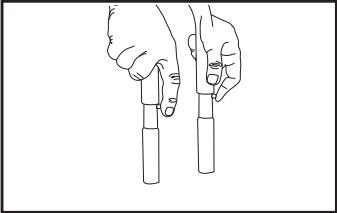
QUICK SETUP GUIDE

(Letters A-C)

A

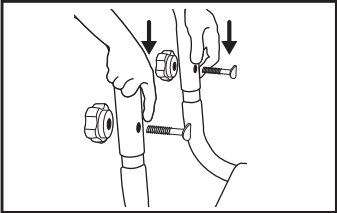
Install the Handle

Place handle onto frame, depress the snap buttons, and slide the handle assembly onto the frame until snap buttons snap into place.

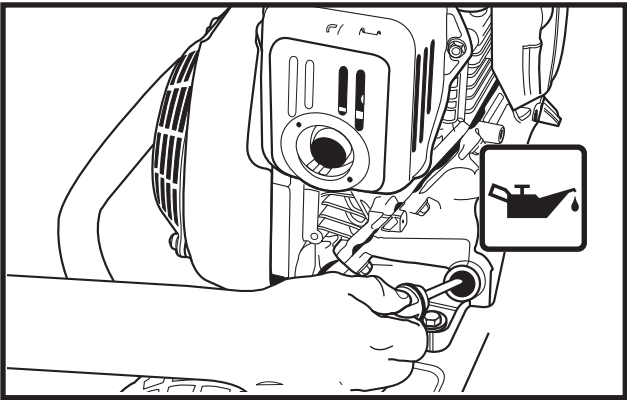
Slide the handle assembly onto the frame and secure with saddle bolts and knobs

Add/Check Oil

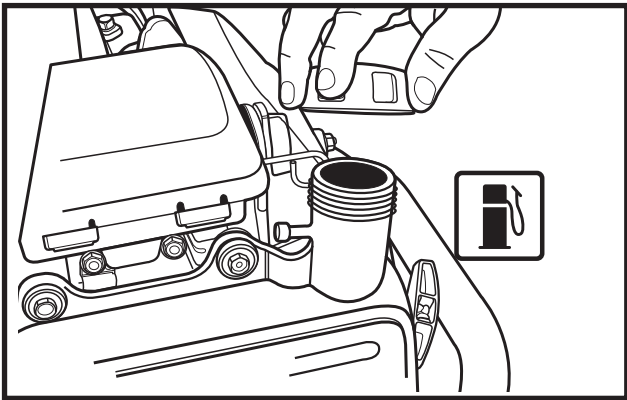
The engine is shipped without oil. Before starting engine, add the oil provided using the oil spout. Check oil level prior to each use. Refer to Engine Owner's Manual for complete procedure.



C

Add Gasoline

In a well ventilated outdoor area add fresh, high quality, unleaded gasoline with a pump octane rating of 86 or higher. Do not overfill. Wipe up spilled fuel before starting the engine. Refer to Engine Owner's Manual for complete procedure.



QUICK START GUIDE

(Numbers 1-11)



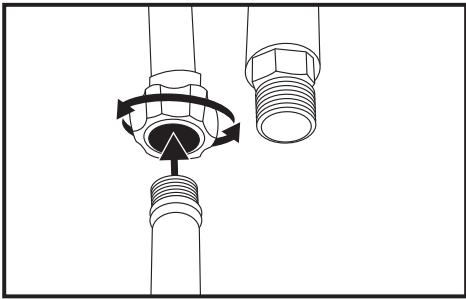
DANGER:

- Never run engine indoors or in enclosed, poorly ventilated areas. Engine exhaust contains carbon monoxide, an odorless and deadly gas.
- Risk of fluid injection and laceration. When using the high-pressure setting, DO NOT allow the high-pressure spray to come in contact with unprotected skin, eyes or with any pets or animals. Serious injury will occur.

Connect Garden Hose to Pump

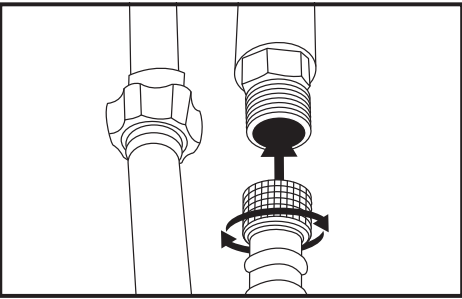
Thread the garden hose to the pump inlet.

Connect High Pressure Hose to Pump

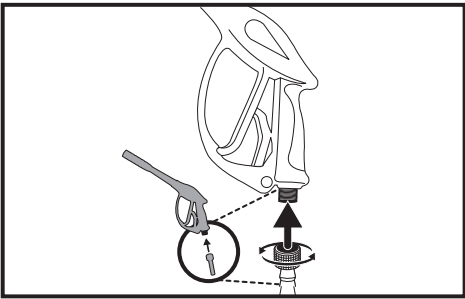
Thread the high pressure hose to the pump outlet.

Connect High Pressure Hose to Spray Gun

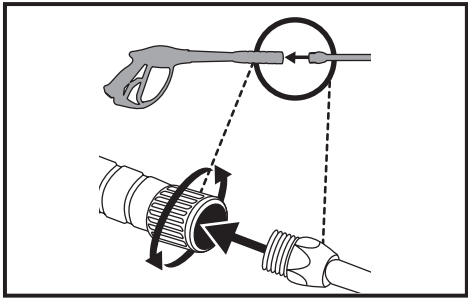
Thread the other end of the high pressure hose to the spray gun.

Connect Spray Wand to Spray Gun

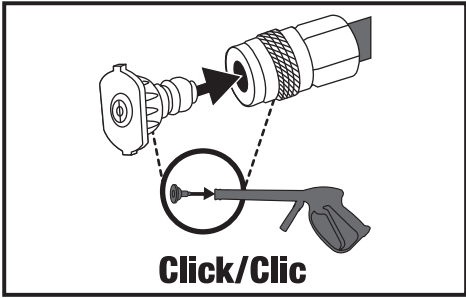
Thread the spray wand into the end of the spray gun.

Connect QC Nozzles to Spray Wand

Pull quick connect coupler back and insert nozzle. Release quick connect coupler and twist nozzle to make sure it is secure in coupler.

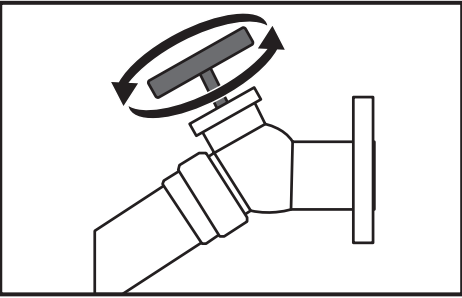

Turn Water Faucet Completely On

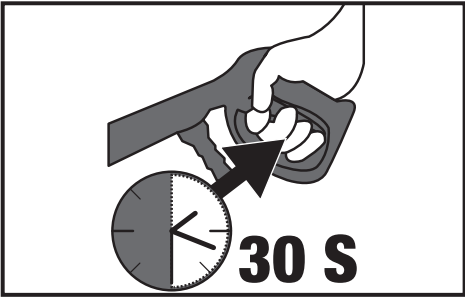
Do not run the unit without water supply connected and turned on. Use Cold Water Only.

Release Air from System

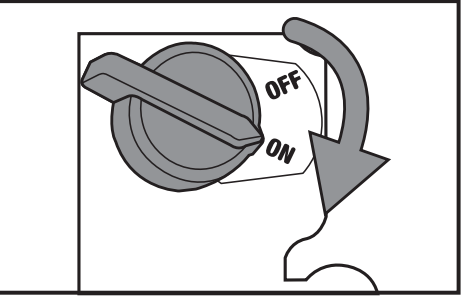
Release all air from pump and high pressure hose by depressing trigger until a steady stream of water is present. Approximately 30 seconds.

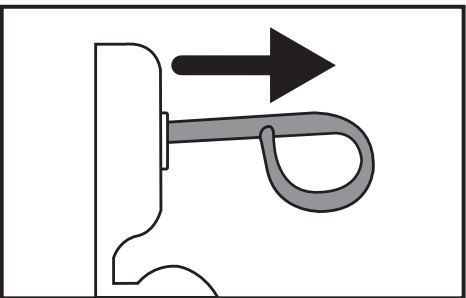
Verify the Engine Switch is turned to the ON Position

Verify the Choke Pin is Pulled Out to the CLOSED Position

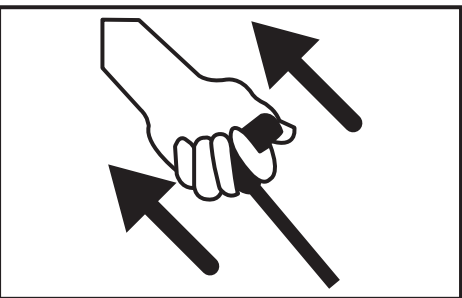
The Choke Pin has been preset by the factory to be in the CLOSED Position.

Pull the Recoil Starter Grip

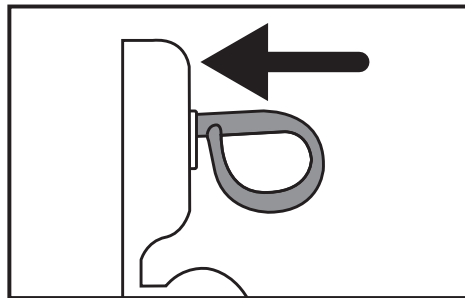
Pull the recoil starter grip to start the engine.

Push the Choke Pin to the OPEN Position

Gradually move the Choke Pin to the OPEN Position after engine starts.

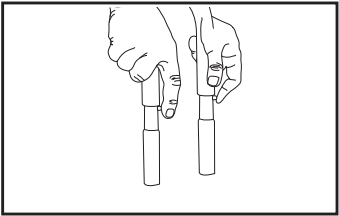

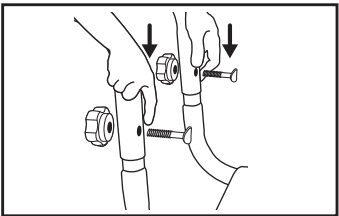
Instale la manija

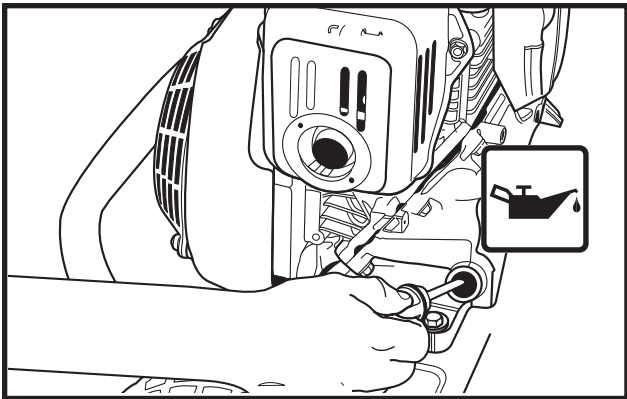
Coloque el manillar en el marco y segura con los pernos y las manillas.

Agregue/revise el aceite

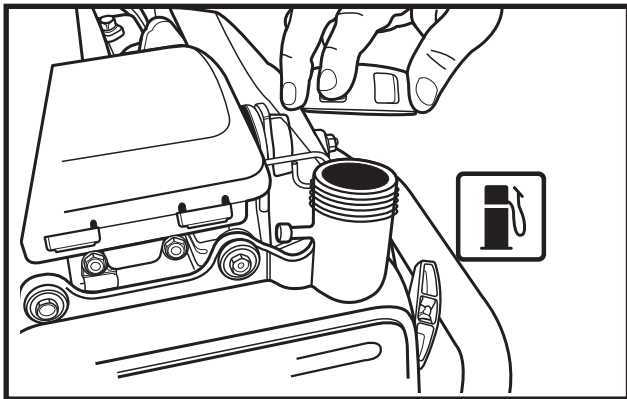

En un área bien ventilada y al exterior, agregue gasolina fresca, de alta calidad y sin plomo con un índice de octanaje de 86 o mayor. No lo llene de más. Limpie todo el combustible derramado antes de encender el motor. Consulte el manual del usuario del motor por el procedimiento completo.



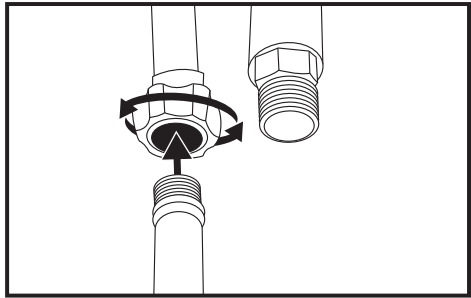

Conecte la manguera de jardín a la bomba

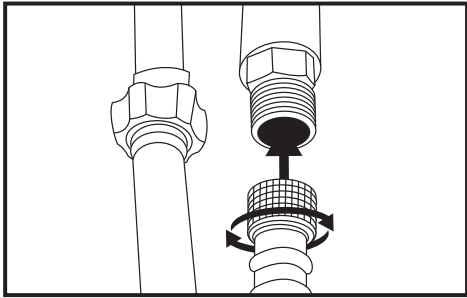
Enrosque la manguera de jardín a la entrada de la bomba.

Conecte la manguera de alta presión a la bomba

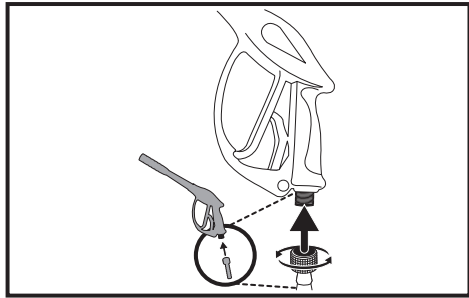
Enrosque la manguera de alta presión a la salida de la bomba.

Conecte la manguera de alta presión a la pistola rociadora

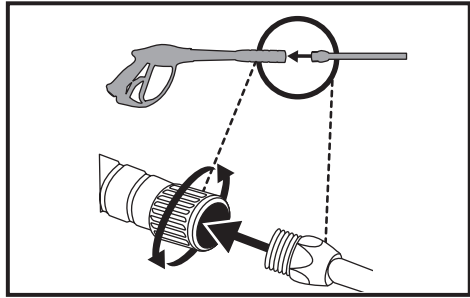
Enrosque el otro extremo de la manguera de alta presión a la pistola rociadora.

Conecte la vara rociadora a la pistola rociadora

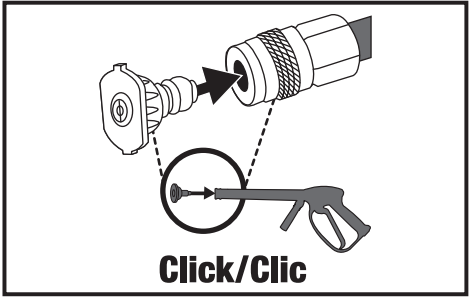
Enrosque la vara rociadora al extremo de la pistola rociadora.

Tire el conector rápido hacia atrás e inserte la boquilla. Suelte el conector rápido y gire la boquilla para verificar que esté bien asegurada en el conector.

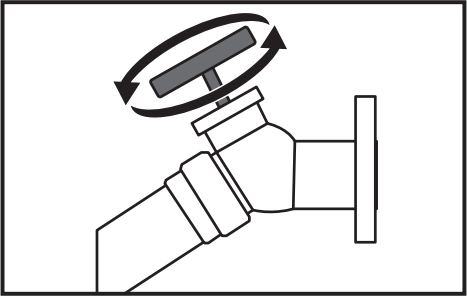

Abra completamente la llave del agua

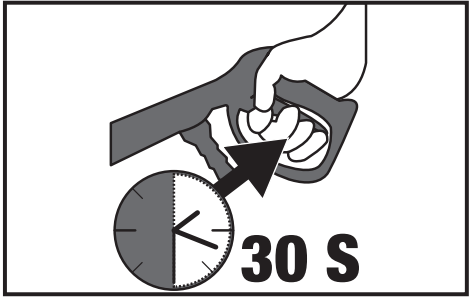
No haga funcionar la unidad sin el suministro de agua conectado y abierto. Use agua fría solamente.

Libere el aire del sistema

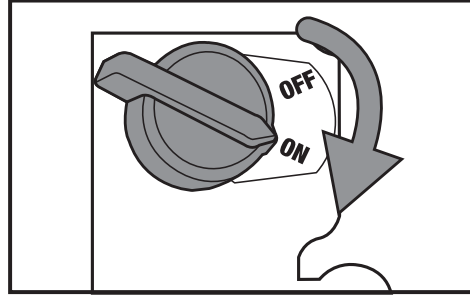

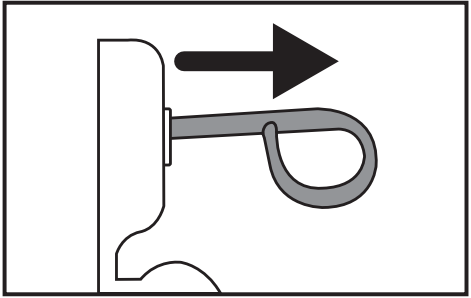

Verifique que el cebador esté hacia afuera de la posición CERRADO

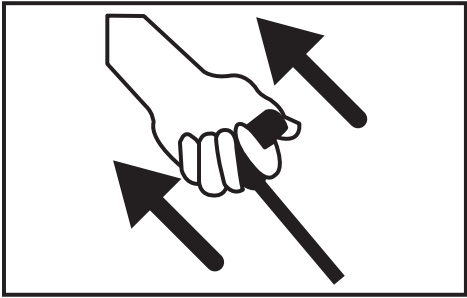
El cebador viene de fábrica en la posición CERRADO.

Tire del arranque manual

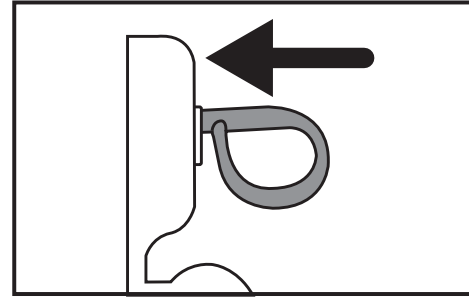
Tire del arranque manual para encender el motor.
