too loose.

Switch on/off

To start the device, press and hold the function button (2) for approx, 5 seconds. To switch off, repeat the action and confirm switching off.

In case when the smartwatch does not start up, try tocharge it.

CHARGING

PAIRING

3. Open the Da Fit application, grant it all permissions and enter the smartwate user data

4. Go to the Device tab, click Add Device, then select the device named CF80

5. When pairing, place the watch close to the phone you are pairing it with.

6. After successful pairing, the data will be fully synchronized. The Garett Women Emma smartwatch works with smartphones that support Bluetooth 5.0 connectivity. It is also compatible with Android 5.1 (and newer) a
